

# Welcome to TRACS AKC Memorial Day Weekend Agility Trial May 28, 29, 30, AND 31, 2021 Yolo County Fairgrounds – Outdoors on grass 1250 East Gum Ave, Woodland, CA 95776

Thank you for entering our AKC Memorial Day Agility Trials. By this time, you have all received an entry confirmation via email. This is a preliminary judging schedule which is contingent upon move up entries that may not have been received yet.

Upon acceptance of your entry, whether you entered through the AKC Online Entry Service or mailed your entry to me, you were emailed an entry confirmation. Please ensure you have read this confirmation carefully. Unless due to a Trial Secretary oversight, errors must be corrected **<u>before</u>** the day of the show. No additions, deletions, or changes may be made after closing except for move ups. If you have anything to change, email kathie@touchngoagility.com.

<u>Move ups for Friday, May 28th are accepted until Monday, May 24, 2021 at 10:00 PM and must be in print</u> <u>(either letter or email)</u>. Although move ups for Saturday, Sunday and Monday will be taken until 15 minutes after the close of the day's event, please consider turning in your move up form as soon as you have confirmed your results.

# **COVID RULES / POLICIES**

# In accordance with California Department of Public Health / Yolo County Fairgrounds guidance:

**Everyone, vaccinated or not,** is required to wear a face covering when attending crowded outdoor events. In the context of our event, this means:

Wear of a face covering is required when:

- Anytime you are within 6' of others who are not of your household unless you know for certain they are fully vaccinated.
- During all walkthroughs
- Anytime you are anywhere close to the rings getting ready to run your dog: there will be three or four marked stations for you to stage at as you get close to going in the ring.
- When approaching the scribe table / gate steward.
- Anytime you approach any of the Trial Management areas: Scoring; Judges' Table; Raffle; Awards; Key Worker Lunch Area

Wear of a face covering is OPTIONAL when:

- In the ring running your dog (but you must put it back on upon leaving the ring)
- Walking alone, away from others (but always carry a mask with you in case you need to put one on)
- Working at a scribe table if ALL table workers are vaccinated (scribe, timer, scribe runner, gate)

Repeated violations of these rules could lead to a Bench Committee Hearing and/or dismissal from the show grounds. This is due to the possible loss of the site to TRACS and other clubs.

# AGILITY TRIAL SITE DIRECTIONS

# **DIRECTIONS:**

From the Bay Area via I-80 East: Take I-80 East towards Sacramento. Exit I-80 onto CA-113 North (just past Dixon) towards Woodland for 8.7 miles. Take Exit 34, Road 25A. Follow Rd 25A for approximately .45 miles and turn right onto East Street. Follow East Street for 1.88 miles and turn right onto East Gum Ave. The fairgrounds will be on your right.

<u>From I-5 North/SR-99 North:</u> If you come up 99, you will merge onto I-5 north just past Sacramento (goes past the Sacramento International Airport). Follow I-5 north to Ex 537, CA 113S / Woodland. Turn left off the exit ramp onto East Main Street. Follow East Main for approximately 1.1 miles, then turn left on East Street. In .6 miles, turn left onto East Gum Ave. Fairgrounds Entrance will be on your right.

#### **ENTERING / EXITING THE FAIRGROUNDS:**

- The Main Gate off of East Gum (Black Gate) will be open from 7:00 am through 8:00 pm. TRACS has NO control over these hours. This gate is opened/closed by the Fairgrounds Maintenance department.
- If you arrive before 7:00 am, you will have to wait in the outer parking area until the gate is opened.
- There is every possibility that Maintenance may be late in opening the gate. Please be patient.

# SET UP DAY (Thu, May 27) SCHEDULE – A quick look:

NOTE TO TRACS KEYWORKERS: In order to arrive before the rest of general exhibitors, you must contact Karey and let her know you are volunteering to work set up. Just because you are a keyworker does not mean you are automatically assumed to be working set up. You have to tell us! If you don't you get to come in with everyone else at 2:00 pm.

- 10:00 am:
  - Equipment trailers arrive.
  - Preliminary marking of Trial Management spaces, ring corners and identification of spaces where no canopies may be set up occurs during this time.
- 11:00 am -12:00 pm: If you are on the Set-Up list, you can arrive as early as 11:00 am. If you are bringing your RV, you may park it now (NOT BEFORE). You may also set up your canopies at ring side. You may save space for ONE friend.
- 12:00 noon: Full set Up begins.
  - NOTE: If you arrive before 2 pm, you must wait in the outer parking lot. Please do not enter the Fairgrounds while the set-up crews are doing their work.
  - If you want to get in early, volunteer to be on the set-up crew (see below)
- 2:00 pm: All exhibitors not on the set-up list can enter the Fairgrounds and set up ringside. You may also find your spot and park your RV after this time.

#### SET UP CREW:

- We'd love to have your help, but we really need you to contact Karey or Sandy in advance to be put on the Set Up Crew list. Because our May AKC trial has never been at Woodland before, we will be figuring out just where things go early in the day. We need to keep the number of people wandering around the grounds and setting up early to be near zero.
- If you wish to help with set up, please contact Karey Krauter (<u>kek@bumpsays.com</u>) by Wednesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. ONLY SET UP CREW will be allowed to set up ringside before 2:00 pm.

#### ARRIVAL AND PARKING:

- Fri Monday: The Main Fairgrounds entrance gate opens at 7:00 am. Again....TRACS has NO control over these hours. This gate is opened/closed by the Fairgrounds Maintenance department. We do not have the keys.
- Main Street (the two-lane road that leads from the Gate down through the trial area), will be blocked off
  in both directions beginning at 7:30 am each day through the end of judging. If you arrive after 7:30 am,
  there is an unloading area where you can park temporarily to unload your stuff or you may drive around

the perimeter (see Daily Driving Map) to a Daily Parking area. There is a 15-minute unloading time limit. After that, you must move your car to one of the day parking areas.

• There are a number of areas inside the Fairgrounds where you can park for the day. See the attached site map for these areas. Please do not park within about 20 feet of an RV hookup or you will be asked to move if an RV needs to park there. No vehicles of any kind (with the exception of the TRACS trailers and tow vehicles), may park on any paved roads/pathways (fire lanes).

# RINGSIDE CANOPY SETUP:

- The rings will be outside on grass with limited shade, so remember to bring your own shade.
- Exhibitor set up opens at 2:00 pm.
- Please ensure all set ups are <u>at least 15' back</u> off the ring ropes.
- Note: TRACS will have marked off reserved areas and walk through spaces during set up. If you set your canopy up in a "designated walk-through area" or other reserved space, you will be asked to move, regardless of the time. See attached Site map.

# UNATTENDED DOGS: In accordance with AKC rules, all dogs must be on leash and attached to a human

**being.** Please do not tie your dog to the TRACS canopies, leave them unattended in/on chairs, or in an unattended down stay next to the ring while walking your course. If you are early in the running order, you can bring a crate to the warm up area to stage your dog so you can be ready immediately following the walk through. However, you will have to remove it after your run to keep congestion down near the rings. Also, remember that, in most cases, there will be a five-minute break from the end of each walk through to the first dog on the line. The only exception is when we have a walk, walk, run scenario. In that case, the judging may begin immediately.

# RV PARKING:

- Overnight parking is by **advance registration only**.
- Only TRACS keyworkers will have <u>assigned</u> parking spots.
- Sandy Zajkowski, our RV Coordinator, will be sending out a general map to all those who have sent in an RV parking request. This map will have RV parking locations identified.
- General RV Parking is on a first come, first serve basis.
- RVers not on the set up list may come in to park at 2:00 pm not before!.
- If you get to the Fairgrounds before 2:00 pm, please wait in the outer parking lot.

**<u>CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG</u>**: Please clean up after your dog. Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people. **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLE!** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals!

# **EXITING THE FAIRGROUNDS:**

- During the day: If you need to depart the Fairgrounds while the trial is underway, you will need to drive the long way around the site back to the main gate. "Main Street" will be closed off in both directions from 7:30 am through the end of judging each day. This is for your safety (and the safety of your dogs).
- See this route on the attached Fairgrounds Map
- The main gate will be closed and locked by maintenance at 8 pm each day. To enter/exit after 8 PM, you will have to use the emergency entrance gate off of East Street.
- FOR AFTER HOURS EMERGENCY EXIT HELP: CONTACT KAREY KRAUTER AT 650-906-5146

**HOSPITALITY:** There will be no exhibitor hospitality this year. Be sure to bring your own food and water.

**WORKERS** : We are using some full time workers, but we can still use lots of other help! Worker Sign up Boards will be posted at ring side. Simply sign up on the white board and listen for the Ring Crew Chief (RCC) to call for your class.

You will earn \$2.00 TRACS Worker Buck per class or division. Once you have signed up, please check in with your ring crew chief 10 minutes before you are scheduled to work. This really helps keep things moving along. Be sure to come to Scoring at the end of your trial to redeem your worker bucks!

### **REDEEMING YOUR TRACS WORKER BUCKS**:

At the end of your weekend, bring all your worker bucks to the <u>Scoring Table</u> and we will give you a single voucher in exchange. After the end of this trial, <u>the individual worker bucks have no value</u>. You MUST turn them in and get a certificate. Anyone at the scoring table can do this exchange for you.

**SCORING, QUESTIONS, POSTING:** Scores will be posted on the Arena Wall near Scoring. Please check your results as soon as possible so we may resolve any questions you may have before the judge forgets what your run was like! If you have a question, ask! While it's true the score table is busy, we are never too busy to help you.

Additionally, our goal is to post each day's results to the TRACS Website each night.

If you have any questions about anything other than scoring, or have any feedback about ways we can improve our trial, don't be shy about saying something (although I've never really known agility people to be shy about expressing their opinions). Track down our Trial Chairs Karey Krauter and Sandy Zajkowski; Trial Co-Chair, Karen O'Neil; our Trial Secretary, Kathie Leggett; or talk to anyone wearing a red or black TRACS shirt/jacket.

#### AWARDS:

- We will have your awards ready as soon as we can, but please be patient. AKC requires judges to review all scribesheets/catalogs prior to awards being available to competitors.
- Awards at this trial are NOT self-serve. Check in with the awards staff for your class stickers and/or placement prizes.
- In addition to rosettes for class placements and qualifying flats, there are special rosettes for Double Qualifying rounds; for new titles; and for any MACH/PACH/AGCH.
- IF YOU MIGHT EARN A MACH/PACH or AGCH AT THIS TRIAL, PLEASE LET OUR TRIAL SECRETARY KNOW AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!! We will have a beautiful, special ribbon for everyone who has let us know, but otherwise, we may run out and you'll have to get yours afterwards in the mail.

**<u>AGILITY GATE APP</u>**: Exhibitors are requested to download the new, free phone app, Agility Gate. The app is free through the iPhone App Store or the Google Play Store. The app has a purple background. The trial code for this event is **0528**.

Run orders will be posted the evening before the event.

The app gives you access to the course maps and this is how you will check in for your classes.

You will not need your phone at the gate. The gate steward will still call your dog's name just like at shows in the past. If you have multiple dogs running too close together in the run, then mark them with a "conflict" via the Gate app. If you do not have access to the Agility Gate app, you can ask a friend to mark the conflict for you or you can request the Gate Steward do this at ringside.

- **MAPS**: Maps will be released on or after 6:00 pm the evening prior to the day (Thu 6 pm for Friday; Friday 6 pm for Sat, etc). Exact timing depends on when the judges sent their maps for uploading.
- **<u>CHECK IN</u>**: You will be able to check in at 6:00 am on the morning of the trial.

**<u>MEASURING</u>**: We will have three Volunteer Measuring Officials at this event. The only dogs that <u>require</u> measuring are those without height cards or dogs over two years of age who only have one measurement. THIS INCLUDES DOGS JUMPING IN THE 24" OR 24C class. Unentered dogs may be measured later in the day.

<u>If you marked that your dog needs to be measured</u>, your dog MUST be measured \*\*<u>BEFORE</u>\*\* running-all heights. Beverly Morgan Lewis, Cindy Macklin, and Kathie Leggett will be our measuring officials for the event.

Morning measuring will be done near the Trial Secretary / Score tables around 7:30 am. Subsequent measuring will be done as required. In general, the VMOs will be available at the top of each hour, so you can plan when to be near the measuring area.

### **TRIAL SCHEDULE** – Please see details on the following pages!

**<u>CONFLICTS</u>**: Conflicts will be handled as needed. If you even THINK you might have a conflict, mark your dog as a "conflict" by using the Agility Gate App, or talk to the Gate Steward and they can assist you. We will do everything we can to make sure you get your run, including resetting jump heights once after all dogs have run, so long as you have told us you have a problem. However, we will not hold a ring open once all dogs present at ringside have run; there are other classes to get going.

Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as possible within their class.

<u>2021 TRACS Parade of Veterans</u> – Rosette Presentations – We will be holding a brief ceremony on Sat morning immediately following the morning briefing (approximately 8:00 am) where we will present this years Parade of Veterans participants with their personalized neck rosettes. Both rings will be closed during this short ceremony so everyone can come and support our Veteran Agility Dogs.

<u>The on Call Vet and the nearest 24 Hour Emergency Veterinarian:</u> UC Davis Veterinary Teaching Hospital; (530)752-1393; Directions will be available at the Trial Secretary's table.

**Live To Run Again Library**: The Live to Run Again audio book library, managed by Penny Larson, will be at the TRACS trial over Memorial Day. After that, Penny is considering retiring the library. With so many of the newer cars not having a CD player, and a seemingly dwindling interest in the library, it may be time. Please let Penny know your thoughts at the trial and help yourself to as many of the audio sets as you wish.



**<u>CHECK-IN</u>**: There is no formal check-in this year. All exhibitors will be checking in via the Agility Gate App after 6:00 am on the trial day.

MAPS: There will not be any hard copy maps available at the trial. You can print your own map through the Agility Gate App or from the TRACS website after 6:00 pm the evening before each trial day.

<u>GENERAL EXHIBITOR BRIEFING</u>: 7:30 am each day. Why come and listen??? Well, this is where you will get information about the trial specific to each day (stuff that may have come up since this judging schedule was published, changes to the schedule, explanation of the day's events/walkthroughs, and anything else our illustrious Trial Chairs or Trial Secretary needs to talk to you about!)

# NOTES TO EXHIBITORS ON SCHEDULE, CLASS ORDER, AND JUMP HEIGHT ORDER:

# There has been a change to the tentative class order that was published in the Premium List: Master FAST will be running before the combined Open/Nov FAST class.

We have put a LOT of work into developing a schedule with an eye towards minimizing conflicts for the greatest number of competitors. Because of this, you will see that the Masters/Excellent classes jump height order switches around. PLEASE review the attached schedule grid carefully! Also, throughout the weekend, there are breaks built into the schedule so you may see a ring having some down time pending the completion of a class in another ring. <u>WE DO NOT PLAN TO CHANGE THIS SCHEDULE (although this MAY happen)</u> just because a ring is down. Please be patient, take a break, and relax and enjoy the show.

#### WALK THROUGH NOTES:

- The first walkthrough each day will begin as soon as the judges approve their courses.
- Any exhibitor entered in both Premier Standard and Master FAST must walk both courses before judging begins. There are no planned additional walk throughs for these classes.
- After judging begins, all subsequent classes and walkthroughs will start when previous class is completed.
- There are no mass walkthroughs after judging begins.
- For Masters/Excellent classes: Be sure to read the attached schedule carefully! In an attempt to reduce conflicts, planned jump height orders from day to day, and on some days, even class to class.
   Walkthrough groups are shown as a series of "xx xx xx"; walkthrough splits are identified with a semicolon "x;"
- Some of the Masters Std and JWW classes are large enough that we have schedule split walkthrough. In these classes, it will be walk, walk run. Judging will begin immediately upon the conclusion of the second walk through.
- STAY FLEXIBLE!!

**<u>FIRST CLASSES JUDGES' BRIEFING</u>**: Will take place at 7:45 am. Subsequent judges' briefings will immediately precede each class.


**JUDGING BEGINS**: 8:00 am each day with the exception of Saturday. On Saturday, judging begins at the conclusion of the Parade of Veterans Rosette presentations.

#### FAST CLASS NOTE:

- Master/Excellent Fast will be run separately; On all days, it will run first in Ring 2 (JWW Ring). This is a change from the tentative class order published in the premium list).
- Open/Novice FAST: We will be running the Open/Nov combo FAST class where the course is set the same for both levels with the different sends. We will be running this class in jump height order: in each jump height, Open dogs will run first, followed by Nov dogs.
