

# **COVID-19 STATEMENT**

AS OF May 1, 2021

**With the progress that has been made against COVID, TRACS is moving forward with our event! There is always a possibility something may happen that would cause a short notice cancellation, but we thinking positively and looking forward to seeing everyone at the Yolo County Fairgrounds in Woodland for our Memorial Day agility trials, May 28-31, 2021.**

**Entries are now open for our Memorial Day agility trials, May 28-31, 2021.**

**If you have entered under the Leone site plan, you may cancel your entry simply by sending me an email. Since we are six weeks prior to closing, you must cancel your entry prior to May 21 to receive your refund. (As a reminder: there is never a refund of any AKC online convenience fees. See below.**

We are going to keep it very basic this year: just our basic slate of classes, the WTT ISC Classes, and the presentation of the Parade of Veterans rosettes (once again, TRACS will be creating a virtual Parade of Agility Veterans and Memorial Video). All other TRACS-sponsored programs have been postponed until next year. HOWEVER...Linda Brisbin is sponsoring a fun Team event on Sat/Sun, May 28/29. This event is open to all dogs, all levels, all jump heights. See details later in the premium.

If we do cancel, **ALL mailed entries fees will be fully refunded**. Any certificates sent with entries will be returned/reissued. If you use the AKC Online Entry service, your entry fees will be refunded by TRACS, but the online convenience fees will not be refunded, as AKC does not refund those fees.

Additionally, in the event of trial cancellation: for those who have entered the Parade of Veterans, TRACS will still order/send you your dog's PoV Rosette.

So, with all this in mind, if you are going to send an entry, please do it sooner than later, so that in the event we can have the trial, your Trial Secretary will not have to try and process a flood of entries at the last minute.

All entry fee checks will be held until the closing date.

With regard to those of you making RV reservations: we are NOT accepting PayPal payments for RV reservations for this show due to the difficulty and costs involved with refunds. Please send a check with your RV reservations to Sandra Zajkowski, our RV Czar, using the form later in the premium list.

**ENTRIES WILL OPEN ON MONDAY, MARCH 15, 2021 at 9:00 am** at the Trial Secretary's address. All entries received before this date will be returned. Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed.

**ENTRIES CLOSE ON FRIDAY, MAY 21, 2021 at 11:30 pm** after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

**Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. **THIS INCLUDES DOGS JUMPING 24"**. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

**IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS**

- If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation information and judging schedule. Please make sure the Trial Secretary's email address: ([kathie@touchngoagility.com](mailto:kathie@touchngoagility.com)) is allowed by your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address.
- **Move ups** will be accepted until **Monday, May 24, 2021 at 6 pm**. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site within **15 minutes** of the last run of each day, but DON'T Wait!! You can turn in your move up as soon as the official results are posted. It really helps us out to get the move ups earlier in the day.

## ENTRY FEES

Daily Entry Fees (per dog): \$21.00 - 1<sup>st</sup> Class / \$15.00 each additional class; ISC Classes - \$10.00 All fees must be paid in U.S. funds only-by cash or check.

## ONLINE vs PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS:

TRACS is accepting Online entries for this trial through AKC Agility Online Entry Service. Go to [www.akc.org/AgilityEntry](http://www.akc.org/AgilityEntry) and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper entries will be as follows: All days: Online Entry, 200 per day; Paper entries: 500. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or the paper limits accordingly.

AKC ONLINE ENTRY REFUND POLICY: **AKC Online convenience fees will not be refunded for any reason.**

SHOW SITE: This show will be held outdoors on grass. Both rings will be 110' long by 100' wide.

## AWARDS

- Ribbons will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height.
- Prizes valued between \$2 and \$5 will be awarded to all dogs placing first through fourth in their class/jump height.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing a title
- Special pins will be awarded to any dog earning a "Double Q (Std/JWW)" or "Triple Q (Std/JWW/FAST)" from the Master classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH/PACH/AGCH. **PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary if you anticipate you may complete your MACH/PACH/AGCH at our trial. Otherwise, we may not have enough rosettes to give to everyone!**
- ISC – rosettes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dogs with qualifying scores in each jump height plus a prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place. In addition, a cash prize will be awarded to the dog with the best combined score from each jump height in the ISC Standard and ISC JWW Classes (dogs must have a score from each class to qualify for the cash award).

## **Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020**

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC): This class is now open to dogs competing at any AKC level!!

### **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend –**

Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form** must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Wait List: Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 11:00 pm on May 21, 2021. Any entries withdrawn that have been received by 11:30 pm on May 21, 2021 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund **less a \$5 processing fee** will be issued to the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on Monday, May 24, 2021 will receive a full refund.

- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and must list "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) for the breed name on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, the exhibitor must provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No."
- Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- **There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season. In the case of injury, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing prior to the trial. The club reserves the right to ask for a doctor's or vet's note in the event of a request for refund.**
- **With the exception of any online entry convenience fees, in the event of a bitch coming into season after closing, full entry fees will be refunded.**
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

- In the event the trial is cancelled due to COVID, all entry fees will be refunded (only exception is that AKC does not refund online entry convenience fees, and TRACS has no control over that).
- **Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry. PLEASE PRINT or use the entry forms fillable .pdf function;** illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Trial Secretary will add a **\$25.00 collection fee** to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a “cash only” basis.
- Handlers of all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of a class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring. There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial. No umbrellas permitted on course during walk throughs.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fee paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. For safety reasons, exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in “bare” feet or open toe shoes.
- Please clean up after your dog. Let’s show them that “Dog People” are clean people.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- **Emergency Veterinarian:** UC Davis Veterinary Medicine Teaching Hospital, Small Animal Clinic, 1 Garrod Dr. Davos. CA 95616; (9530)752-1393. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

- All entries must include the signed COVID Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk. No mailed entry will be accepted/processed without this waiver included. All entries submitted via the AKC Online Entry system must be followed up within 7 days with a mailed/emailed signed copy of the waiver.

### **AGILITY TRIAL SITE DIRECTIONS**

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

**From the Bay Area via I-80 East:** Take I-80 East towards Sacramento. Exit I-80 onto CA-113 North (just past Dixon) towards Woodland for 8.7 miles. Take Exit 34, Road 25A. Follow Rd 25A for approximately .45 miles and turn right onto East Street. Follow East Street for 1.88 miles and turn right onto East Gum Ave. The fairgrounds will be on your right.

**From I-5 North/SR-99 North:** If you come up 99, you will merge onto I-5 north just past Sacramento (goes past the Sacramento International Airport). Follow I-5 north to Ex 537, CA 113S / Woodland. Turn left off the exit ramp onto East Main Street. Follow East Main for approximately 1.1 miles, then turn left on East Street. In .6 miles, turn left onto East Gum Ave. Fairgrounds Entrance will be on your right.

### **OVERNIGHT PARKING (RVs; Cars; Vans, etc):**

COST: \$30/night with power; \$10/night dry camping (no power, water),

ONLY TRACS KEYWORKER RVs will have pre-assigned spaces. All other RV parking inside the Fairgrounds will be first come, first served. **You must still send in an Overnight Parking/Camping Form (found later in the premium) accompanied by payment.** PAYPAL may not be used at this trial. TRACS will issue Overnight Parking/Camping Permits that must be displayed while parked during the trial.

If you arrive before TRACS has had an opportunity to mark reserved RV spots, and you end up parked in a spot that has been reserved for a keyworker, you will be required to move.

An RV site map will be included with the Judging schedule so you will have some idea of what power is available in which locations and where water may be available.

There is an actual RV Park in the area between Gum Ave and the Chain Link gate (to your right as you drive in). To reserve a space there, you will NOT send in your RV reservation. This park is run/managed by the Fairgrounds. This Park has 30/50 amp power, water, and sewer. Cost here is \$35.00 / night. **Dry Camping (no hook ups):** RV, Car, Van, Tent: \$10.00. Dry Campers may not park/camp in any spot that has a power hookup.



## **INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES – AKC World Team Tryouts Qualifier**

Purpose of the International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is to provide the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the “Challenge of the Day” when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: This class is open all dogs eligible to compete in AKC Agility competitions. **There is no Preferred Option for ISC;** dogs may enter at their preferred jump height; however, they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

Jump Heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump height, however, only those dogs in the 12” & 16” class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs), or any dog entering the 24” or 24C jump height will be eligible for the direct invitation to the 2021 World Team Tryouts.

Small (12” jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 ¾” and/or less at the withers  
 Medium (16” jump height) – for dogs measuring over 13 ¾” but 16 7/8” or less  
 Large (24” jump height) – for dog measuring over 16 7/8”

**ISC Combined Class Winners:** Combined scores from ISC Jumpers and ISC Standard classes at this event will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award.

- To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award the team must have a minimum of one clean ISC run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score.
- **The Combined Class winners from the 12-, 16- and 24-inch height are invited to attend both the 2021 (if they are held) AND the 2022 AKC World Team Tryouts!** They do not need to fulfill the requirement of the 3/3 scores.
  - The team must also send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility (including an approved pedigree).
  - The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award.

### **HEIGHT DIVISION CHART**

*Exhibitors* may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately. Dogs measuring over 22” at the shoulder are not eligible to enter 24” Choice.

## AGILITY TRIAL COVID-19 SAFETY PROCEDURES Yolo County Fairgrounds, Woodland, CA

The following set of rules and guidelines were developed using CDC, California State, Yolo County, and AKC Guidelines for the safety of our officials, volunteers, and exhibitors.

These guidelines may be modified if we receive new information from Federal, State, or County authorities. These changes may occur up until the date of the trials. Please make sure you download the latest version just prior to the event so you know what to expect on your trial day(s).

Participants must be responsible for their personal hygiene and health. Individuals must be responsible for maintaining physical distancing for themselves and their dogs in the competition area, in the dog walking areas, crating areas, RV parking, camping spaces, and parking lots. Anyone not following club listed/posted procedures while on the property will be asked to leave and, if an exhibitor, no refund will be given. Additional safety precautions are listed below:

- **Face Coverings:** In accordance with California State and Yolo County guidance, dated Apr 15, 2021, the guidelines governing the wear of face masks has been changed as follows:
  - Individuals are exempt from wearing face coverings in the following specific settings:
    - Persons who are outdoors and maintaining at least 6 feet of social distance from others not in their household. Such persons must have a face covering with them at all times and must put it on if they are within 6 feet of others who are not in their household.
  - So, that said: masks are not required to be worn unless you cannot maintain the 6 feet social distance. You **MUST** always carry your mask in case you must come within 6 feet of someone not in your household.
  - Masks must be worn anytime you are in the following areas if others are there:
    - Scoring
    - Judges' Table
    - Awards
    - Raffle
    - Bathrooms
- **Crating:**
  - Crating spaces / canopy edges must be at least 6 feet apart except for household groups of exhibitors and dogs.

- Agility Gate App – We will be using the Agility Gate app for the trial so you can keep track of where we are on your smart phone. Please go to [agilitygate.com](http://agilitygate.com) or your app store to download/update the app on the Thursday before the trial. If you download it before that, you may need to update again. Course maps will be published in the Agility Gate App. No printed copies will be available. The gate app will allow for:
  - Downloading course maps the evening prior to competition.
  - Checking in for each class, including scratching your entry and marking a conflict
  - Checking to see when you need to be at the ring to run by seeing in real time the mark off of dogs that have already run
  
- Rings
  - Sanitation stations will be provided at strategic locations with hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies.
  - No exhibitor chairs will be allowed in the center area between the rings or within 6 feet from the side of the ring.
  - Participants must maintain 6-foot physical distancing as much as possible.
  - **All ring crew must wear a mask during the running of each class only if physical distancing cannot be maintained.**
  - Gate Steward will still be announcing the next dogs to run but each exhibitor is responsible for checking-in via the Agility Gate app.
  
- Dog Measuring – measuring will only be performed by a VMO, if one is available.
  - Jan and Dale will NOT be measuring dogs.
  - ~~VMO will sanitize hands between each dog.~~
  - The VMO will be wearing a face covering, so please practice with your dog having a person wearing a mask around them.
  
- Awards / Ribbons / Ribbon Labels:
  - **Will not be self-serve – do we want to change this?**
  - **Result will be posted on the wall near the Scoring area or other easily accessible area, or on the TRACS website. Remember to keep physical distance while you wait your turn.**
  - **A designated person will be in the awards area to pass out ribbon stickers, placement awards, and ribbons, after the judge approves the results for each class.**
  
- Workers Raffle
  - We will be having our Workers Raffle with a drawing each day.
  - BYOP – Bring your own pen! No pens will be available at the Raffle table.
  - Only one person at a time in the Raffle area; please maintain 6-foot physical distance while waiting your turn
  - Raffle items not picked up by the end of the trial on Monday will be forfeited.
  
- Walk-Thrus
  - It is mandatory that exhibitors wear face coverings during all walk throughs (face shields alone are not allowed).
  - To enable as much physical distancing as possible during walk throughs, we will have smaller walk-through groups of no more than 25 exhibitors in the ring at a time.
  
- Running the Course

- To help exhibitors maintain 6-foot physical distancing while preparing to run, markers will be placed outside the ring near the in gate to designate proper spacing.
  - Only the next THREE teams to run will be allowed in the designated waiting areas
    - #1 is in the ring
    - #2 is at the in gate
    - #3 is at the next physical distance marker
  - At each handler's discretion, face coverings may be removed when they move to the #2 position, but not before.
- Leashes
    - Exhibitors may choose to carry their leash in their pocket, but it must fit fully inside the pocket
    - Exhibitors may choose to "wear" the leash around their waist or crossbody, however, if the dog takes hold of the leash at any time while on the course, this will result in an "E".
- Bathrooms
    - The doors to the permanent bathrooms will be blocked open.
    - Will have proper hand washing supplies.
    - ~~○ Additionally, there will be porta potties available with hand sanitizer in each one.~~
- Hospitality
    - There will be no hospitality of any kind available to exhibitors. Nor will there be any food vendors on site. Please plan to bring your own food. There are no fast-food places nearby.
    - We also ask that you do not bring MACH/PACH cakes at this time.
- Workers
    - Ring workers must only wear a face covering if social distance cannot be maintained. The only exception to this is if all workers in close proximity are fully vaccinated.
    - Leash runners may use the "grab it" tool to pick up leashes. This tool will be wiped down after each leash runner.
    - If the Timer and Scribe are both fully vaccinated, they may sit closer than 6 feet. Otherwise, they must maintain the prescribed 6' social distance.
    - ~~○ Only the assigned scribe runner will handle the scribe sheets between the ring and scoring so there are minimal number of people handling trial paperwork.~~
    - We will have two containers for Gate and Scribe pens, one labeled "Clean" and one labeled "used". Used ones will be cleaned throughout the day for reuse
    - Tables and Chairs will be wiped down between change of workers.
- Judges' Tables
    - ~~○ Each Judge will have their own table near Scoring. Our judges are married and living in the same trailer. I think they can share a work table.~~
    - We recognize that exhibitors may need to approach the judges to discuss concerns, however, this must be done away from the judges' tables and the scoring area.
    - Judges must wear face coverings when near the Score Tables.
- Addressing Scoring Concerns
    - If an exhibitor needs to talk with the Score Table crew, face coverings must be worn, 6-foot physical distance must be observed, and only one non-scoring person may be in the scoring area at a time.

- No prior day results books will be available.
- Results will be physically posted onsite and uploaded to the TRACS website as soon as possible at the end of each trial day.
