### **IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS:**

#### MURIETA RELEASE FORM – REQUIRED

Murieta Equine Complex requires all competitors to sign a release waiver in order to participate in events at MEC. There is a fillable pdf at the end of this premium list that you must complete and return with your entry UNLESS you entered the SDTC trials earlier this year. The waivers that you signed for those trials will carry over to this one.

- If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation information and judging schedule. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address.
- There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial.
- Move ups will be accepted until **6 pm Monday, December 24, 2012**. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site within 30 minutes of the end of each day's trial.
- ENTRY FEES (PER DOG, PER DAY): \$21.00 - 1<sup>ST</sup> Class; \$16.00 – 2<sup>ND</sup>/3<sup>RD</sup> class (includes AKC Recording Fees).
- SHOW SITE: This show will be held outdoors under cover on dirt. Ring dimensions will be 100 wide ' by 100' long per ring.

#### AWARDS

- Rosettes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height.
- Prizes valued between \$2 and \$5 will be awarded to all dogs placing first through fourth in their class/jump height.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing a title or earning a "Double Q" from the Excellent B classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH. If you anticipate you may complete your MACH at our trial, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**Wait List:** Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 pm on December 14, 2012. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on December 24, 2012 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund less a \$5 processing fee will be issued to the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on December 24, 2012 will receive a full refund.

- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and must list "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) for the breed name on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, the exhibitor must provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No."
- Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- **EXCEPT IN A WAIT LIST SITUATION, There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing (email is acceptable, but MUST be sent return receipt to confirm we did receive it) prior to the trial.** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry-PLEASE PRINT;** illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- Handlers of all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of a class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring. There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial. No umbrellas permitted on course during walk throughs.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fee paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet. .
- Please clean up after your dog. Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.

**SITE:** Murieta Equine Center, 7200 Lone Pine Drive, Rancho Murieta, CA 95683

This site is outdoors undercover on rolled packed dirt. There will be two 110' x 100' rings.

**DIRECTIONS:**

From Sacramento/Bay Area: Take Hwy 50 east towards Lake Tahoe. Exit at Sunrise Blvd. Turn right off the exit ramp and proceed for 7.4 miles to Jackson Rd (Hwy 16). Turn left on Jackson Road and proceed 7.1 miles to Lone Pine Rd. Turn right on Lone Pine. Murieta Equine Complex is immediately on your right.

From Reno: Take Hwy 80 towards Sacramento. Exit at Sierra College Blvd. Turn South. After a few miles, Sierra College Blvd becomes Hazel Ave. Follow Hazel Blvd to Hwy 50 WEST. Exit Hwy 50 at Sunrise Blvd. Turn left off the exit ramp and follow directions above.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: REGULAR TITLING CLASS**

- Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an AKC agility title.
- Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.
- Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.
- Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.
- Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: PREFERRED TITLING CLASSES**

Open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in AKC Agility Trial regulations. Dogs may be entered in either Preferred class or the Regular class at any trial. The dog must be entered ONLY in Preferred or Regular classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. So, if you want to enter your dog in Preferred classes on Sat, you must also enter Preferred on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday.

- Novice – All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level regardless of the previous titles. Novice Preferred is NOT split into A and B divisions.
- Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice Preferred or Open Preferred titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent Preferred class.
- Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open Preferred title, but have not completed the Excellent Preferred title.
- Excellent B – For dogs that have completed the Excellent Preferred title.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: F.A.S.T. – Fifteen and Send Time**

The focus of the FAST class is to test the skill, timing and distance work involved in a game of strategy and point accumulation.

- Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an agility title.
- Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.
- Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.
- Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.
- Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: TIME TO BEAT:**

Purpose: This optional agility titling class is meant to challenge the handler/dog to set a clean efficient line with an emphasis on speed and accuracy. The dog that sets the quickest time in each jump height will set the time to beat, for that jump height. There will be a single class level and all dogs with any skill level (e.g. Novice, Open, Excellent) will compete on the same course.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program SM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

For valuable consideration and to induce permission to participate in canine activities held at Murieta Equestrian Center ("MEC"), 7200 Lone Pine Drive, Rancho Murieta, CA 95683, each of the undersigned agrees to the following terms and makes the following warranties:

I acknowledge that participating in canine activities, whether as a show participant or an audience member, is a HAZARDOUS RECREATION ACTIVITY with RISK of damage or PERSONAL INJURY, including PARALYSIS OR DEATH, to any person or property. Canines have the propensity to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around the canine; have unpredictable reactions to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; are susceptible to certain hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions, collisions with other canines or objects; propensities include kicking, biting, stamping, stumbling, rearing, and others; tack equipment can fail resulting in falling or loss of control; and activities have the potential of the participant(s) to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the canines or not acting within the participant's ability. Canine activities are INHERENTLY DANGEROUS. I understand this is not a complete description of all risks and that other unknown or unforeseeable hazards and risks of harm may occur.

With this in mind, I accept full responsibility for my own safety and EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM, whether foreseen or unforeseen while participating in canine activities at the Murieta Equestrian Center. **I am physically fit and know of no medical or health reason why I should not participate in this activity.**

I hereby RELEASE and agree to DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS MEC, Cosumnes Corporation, Foxfarms, Inc., their shareholders, officers, employees, agents, instructors, equipment manufacturers, lessors, and insurers (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties Released"), from and against any liability, demand, claim, or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE of MEC or other Parties Released.
