CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Thursday, December 3, 2020, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. All entries must be delivered to Karey Krauter, 374 Stanford Ave, Palo Alto CA 94306. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

TEST LIMIT: Entry is limited to five (5) dogs.

ENTRY FEE: \$75.00 payable in US dollars (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event fee). Make checks payable to TRACS.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be at 6:15 PM on Thursday, December 3, 2020, outside of Starbucks, located at 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto CA 94306.

NOTIFICATION: Notification of draw results will be made as soon as possible **via e-mail**. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, contact the Test Secretary.

ELIGIBILITY: The TDU is for all AKC registered dogs not less than six (6) months of age that are eligible for entry and that meet AKC eligibility requirements. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the titles TD, TDU, TDX or VST. Dogs not holding any tracking title will be given priority for entry in the test. Dogs not holding any tracking title must include a judge's certification with their entry.

WORKER PREFERENCE: Preference for the first 1 track drawn will be given to TRACS/SDTC test workers who submit TRACS/SDTC issued vouchers with their entry forms. See the TRACS website at agiltracs.org for details of the test worker preference process.

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

TEST HOURS: 6AM to 4PM. Judging will begin as soon as tracks have aged sufficiently.

FOOD: Be aware that there will be NO FOOD (lunch, snacks) at this event, out of an abundance of caution regarding covid. We will have bottled water available. Please bring your own snacks and lunch as you see fit!

PARKING FEES: there are no parking fees at this park.

DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: All entrants must be at the test site by 9:00 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

AWARDS: A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each passing dog.

DOGS ON LEASH: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate. Notify Test Secretary as soon as you arrive if your bitch is in season.

DOGS IN VEHICLES: Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the sponsoring club for disciplinary action. All persons attending this test hereby waive any claim for damages against TRACS or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person; theft of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal; or any loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site or in transit to/from the site.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE:

From Highway 99 S - Exit Elk Grove Blvd. Turn left onto Elk Grove Blvd.

From Highway 99 N - Exit Elk Grove Blvd. Turn left onto E. Stockton Blvd. Turn right onto Elk Grove Blvd.

From Elk Grove Blvd: Turn right onto Elk Grove-Florin Road. Turn right at Gate 1, Main Entrance, to enter Elk Grove Regional Park. Follow park signs to the Dog Park which will be on the right. Test HQ is in the Dog Park parking lot, at the end of the parking lot where the restrooms are, opposite of the fenced dog run area.

Elk Grove Regional Park is city property and proof of current rabies vaccination for each dog on site may be required. In order to protect our right to use the property, respect others using the area and follow all rules in effect, including leash laws.

COVID-19 Best Practices

Our goal is to keep everyone as safe as we can. If any exhibitor is sick, know they have been exposed to COVID-19 or uncomfortable with the precautions the club is taking, **do not enter**, and stay home. Our mental and physical well-being is most important at all times. Remember when entering a tracking test, it is done at your own risk. If you have not read the Agreement in your trial entry, you should do so now and be aware of what you are signing.

We will be following the rules and guidelines set forward by our state, county, and local agencies along with CDC and AKC guidelines. Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers, and exhibitors as safe as possible.

- ❖ Mask wearing is REQUIRED when in close proximity to others (bring your own mask).
- ❖ Wash hands as frequently as possible. Bring your own hand sanitizer.
- ❖ Leave at least a vehicle or two spaces between your vehicles. There is plenty of parking.
- ❖ Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines.
- ❖ Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- ❖ Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
- ❖ Avoid touching dogs that are not yours, as the owner may have kissed their dog.
- ❖ Avoid common use of pens/pencils – bring your own.
- ❖ The gallery should practice social distancing guidelines.

Tracklayers WILL be handling/scenting the articles. If you are uncomfortable handling the articles, please wear disposable/washable gloves (bring your own gloves).

Remember - if you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR you are unwilling to follow our Best Practices, it would be best you do not enter any test.

IMPORTANT RESTRICTIONS REGARDING COMPETING UNDER YOUR TRACKING BUDDY 30 Day Rules

1. No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within thirty (30) days prior to the date of the event. **(AKC Tracking Regulations, April 1, 2019, Chapter 1, Section 12, pg. 4)**
2. People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 30 days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler. The judges will determine the order in which the tracks are run and the number of each track. The judges may modify the draw to meet the requirements of the tracklayer. **(AKC Tracking Regulations, April 1, 2019, Chapter 2, Section 10, pg. 10)**

COVID-19 RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

By completing and signing an entry for this event, exhibitor agrees to the following:

The risks of COVID-19 are not well understood, including all of the ways in which it can spread and how to determine whether someone is infected at any given point in time. Evidence suggests COVID-19 is extremely contagious and can lead to severe illness, personal injury, permanent disability, and death. Participating in a Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento AKC Tracking Trial ("Event") could increase the risk of contracting COVID-19. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Club, Trial Chair, Trial Secretary, or Event Committee, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in the Event.

COVID-19 LIABILITY WAIVER

Below is a COVID-19 Liability waiver which must be signed and included with your entry form.

I attest to the best of my knowledge that I do not have COVID-19 at the time of attending this event. I also attest that I have not knowingly been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 14 days. I will follow all AKC, TRACS, City, County, State rules and requirements to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus during the Event.

I declare that I will not participate in or attend the Event if:

- I. I test positive or presumptively positive for COVID-19 or am identified as a potential carrier of COVID-19 or similar communicable illness within 21 days of the Event date;
- II. I am in close contact with or care for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the Event date;
- III. I experience any symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19 or cold or flu-like symptoms within 21 days of the Event date (fever, cough, shortness of breath or other respiratory problem).

I understand that if any of the above occur, I may not attend the Event and I may notify the Trial Secretary and receive a full refund.

I will follow all Club rules and requirements ("Rules") to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading COVID-19. The Rules are contained in the Event premium and/or will be sent to me prior to the Event. As this situation continues to evolve, I understand the rules in the Event premium may change prior to the Event, and I will follow the latest Rules communicated to me prior to the Event.
