CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Thursday, January 20, 2022, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 payable in US dollars (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event fee). Make checks payable to TRACS.

ELIGIBILITY: All AKC recognized breeds that have earned a TD or TDU title are eligible to enter this test. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the TDX title. Priority shall be given to dogs that do not hold the TDX title.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be at 6:15 PM on Thursday, January 20, 2022, at Starbucks, located at 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto CA 94306. Entrants will be notified of the results of the draw immediately by email.

TEST WORKER OPTION: One (1) track will be reserved for test workers who have earned sufficient required credit at past TRACS/SDTC tests. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test worker is chosen. The remaining test worker entrants will automatically be included in the drawing with all the other tracking entries received. See the TRACS website at agiltracs.org for details of the test worker preference process.

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

IMPORTANT - 30-DAY RULE IS NOW A 10-DAY RULE:

- No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within ten (10) days prior to the date of the event (Chap 1, Section 12, paragraph 8).
AKC Tracking change announced 11/23/20, effective 01/01/21
- People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 10 days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler. The judges will determine the order in which the tracks are run and the number of each track. (Chap 2, Section 9, paragraph 4).
AKC Tracking change announced 11/23/20, effective 01/01/21

TEST HOURS: 6:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Judging will begin as soon as tracks have aged sufficiently.

DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: All entrants must be at the test site by 9:30 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

AWARDS: A rosette ribbon will be awarded to each passing team.

BITCHES IN SEASON: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

DOGS ON LEASH: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the bench show Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim against TRACS and its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person; theft of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal; or any loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site or in transit to/from the site.

VACCINATIONS: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

ARBITRATION: This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

SITE INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS: From Sacramento, take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Zinfandel Dr. South exit. Continue on Zinfandel Rd until you reach Douglas Rd. Continue straight on Zinfandel Rd through the signal. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. **From Placerville**, take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions. Tracking test headquarters is under the gazebo at the Mather Field Rotary Park.

Mather land availability has undergone many recent changes. For official purposes, we are allowed to use only the land immediately north of the headquarters, and the strip of land starting at the south east corner of Mather Blvd and Arnold Rd (near the church), extending south to the large ditch, and ending near Convair Liner Rd (interior road with yellow gate). However, it appears that the public continues to access areas of land formerly owned by the park in an unofficial capacity. Use discretion when practicing at the park. Please respect all "No Dogs" posted signs.

SPECTATOR/DRIVING ACCESS. We are no longer officially allowed any vehicle access on any of the interior roads. We will likely need to drive to the west side of the park when staging for some of the tracks, and there is likely to be a significant walk for exhibitors and spectators (if allowed) into and out of the areas. **In addition, the area available for exercising dogs during the event has changed** - please look for marked area and/or inquire before exercising your dog at the site.

PRACTICING: Limited practicing on the test site is permitted with these restrictions. No training on the grounds is permitted on the day of the test. Please refrain from using the fields at least 3 days before the test. Please respect all "No Dogs" posted signs.

PARKING FEES: Participants and spectators are responsible for payment of all daily parking fees and must observe all parking regulations. Parking regulations are enforced 24 hours, 7 days per week, 365 days per year (including Sundays & holidays). The fee is \$5 per day payable in cash or credit card on site.

COVID-19 BEST PRACTICES

Our goal is to keep everyone as safe as we can. If any exhibitor is sick, know they have been exposed to COVID-19 or uncomfortable with the precautions TRACS is taking, **do not enter**, and stay home. Our mental and physical well-being is most important at all times. Remember when entering a tracking test, it is done at your own risk. If you have not read the Agreement in your trial entry, you should do so now and be aware of what you are signing.

We will be following the rules and guidelines set forward by our state, county, and local agencies along with CDC and AKC guidelines. Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers, and exhibitors as safe as possible.

- If you travel out of the country within 14 days of the test, STAY HOME.
- If you have a cough, sore throat, shortness of breath or problems breathing, fever/chills, muscle pain or a loss of taste or smell, STAY HOME.
- If you have recently been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has symptoms listed above, STAY HOME.

At the test:

- Wear facial masks when in close proximity to others and/or when required by the club (**bring your own mask**). Masks will be worn over the nose and mouth at all times. Facial netting and masks with vents or valves are **NOT** acceptable facial covering or masks.
- Wash hands as frequently as possible. **Bring your own hand sanitizer.**
- Leave at least a vehicle or two spaces between your vehicles. There is plenty of parking.
- Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines.
- Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
- Avoid touching dogs that are not yours, as the owner may have kissed their dog.
- Avoid common use of pens/pencils – bring your own.
- The gallery should practice social distancing guidelines.

Tracklayers WILL be handling/scenting the articles. If you are uncomfortable handling the articles, please wear disposable/washable gloves (bring your own gloves).

Remember - if you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR you are unwilling to follow our Best Practices, it would be best you do not enter our tests.

COVID-19 RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

By completing and signing an entry for this event, exhibitor agrees to the following:

The risks of COVID-19 are not well understood, including all of the ways in which it can spread and how to determine whether someone is infected at any given point in time. Evidence suggests COVID-19 is extremely contagious and can lead to severe illness, personal injury, permanent disability, and death. Participating in a Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento AKC Tracking Trial ("Event") could increase the risk of contracting COVID-19. - I. I test positive or presumptively positive for COVID-19 or am identified as a potential carrier of COVID-19 or similar communicable illness within 21 days of the Event date;

- III. I experience any symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19 or cold or flu-like symptoms within 21 days of the Event date (fever, cough, shortness of breath or other respiratory problem).

I understand that if any of the above occur, I may not attend the Event and I may notify the Trial Secretary and receive a full refund.

I will follow all Club rules and requirements ("Rules") to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading COVID-19.
