

DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: All entrants must be at the test site by 9:00 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

AWARDS: A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each passing dog.

DOGS ON LEASH: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

ELIGIBILITY: All AKC recognized breeds that have earned a TD, TDU, or TDX title are eligible to enter this test. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the VST title. Priority shall be given to dogs that do not hold the VST title.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate. Notify Test Secretary as soon as you arrive if your bitch is in season.

DOGS IN VEHICLES: Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the sponsoring club for disciplinary action. All persons attending this test hereby waive any claim for damages against TRACS or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person; theft of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal; or any loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site or in transit to/from the site.

CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Thursday, October 24, 2019, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. All entries must be delivered to Karey Krauter, 374 Stanford Ave, Palo Alto CA 94306. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

TEST LIMIT: Entry is limited to three (3) dogs.

ENTRY FEE: \$125.00 payable in US dollars (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event fee). Make checks payable to TRACS.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be at 6:15 PM on Thursday, October 24, 2019, at Starbucks, located at 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto CA 94306.

WORKER PREFERENCE: Preference for the first 1 track drawn will be given to TRACS/SDTC test workers who submit TRACS/SDTC issued vouchers with their entry forms. See the TRACS website at agiltracs.org for details of the test worker preference process.

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

NOTIFICATION: Notification of the draw results will be made by email as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

DRAWING TIME: 10:00AM PST (**Daylight Savings Time ENDS on Saturday night Nov 2!**)

DRAWING SITE: Cosumnes River College – 8401 Center Parkway, Sacramento, CA. Draw will be done at Test HQ which is in parking lot “F”. See attached campus map.

DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: All dogs and handlers must be at the Test area by **10:00 am Sunday, November 3, 2019** at which time there will be a drawing to determine the running order. Entrants not present at the time of the drawing will be marked absent. There were only three entries received for this test, so the test will only use the Cosumnes River College campus. An alternate track may be laid but if it is not used due to a failure in one of the first three tracks, then it will not be used. Numbers 101-103 are in the test.

Bitches in Season MAY participate, provided that the Test Secretary and judges are notified of same prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Please park well away from the other entrants.

JUDGING: Judging will begin as soon as the tracks have aged sufficiently.

DIRECTIONS: From Highway 99 south, exit the Cosumnes River College Boulevard exit and go west. Turn left on Bruceville Road. The college will be on your right (high levees surround the entire campus) and enter at the first entrance to the college on your right. 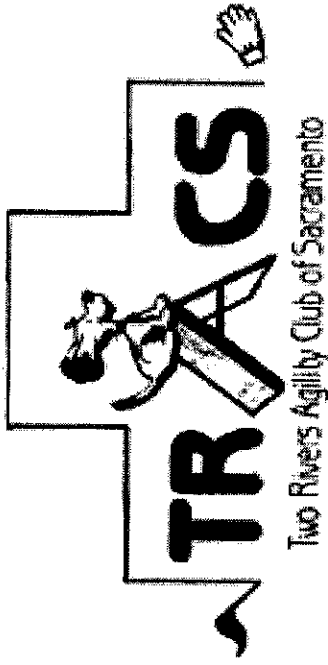

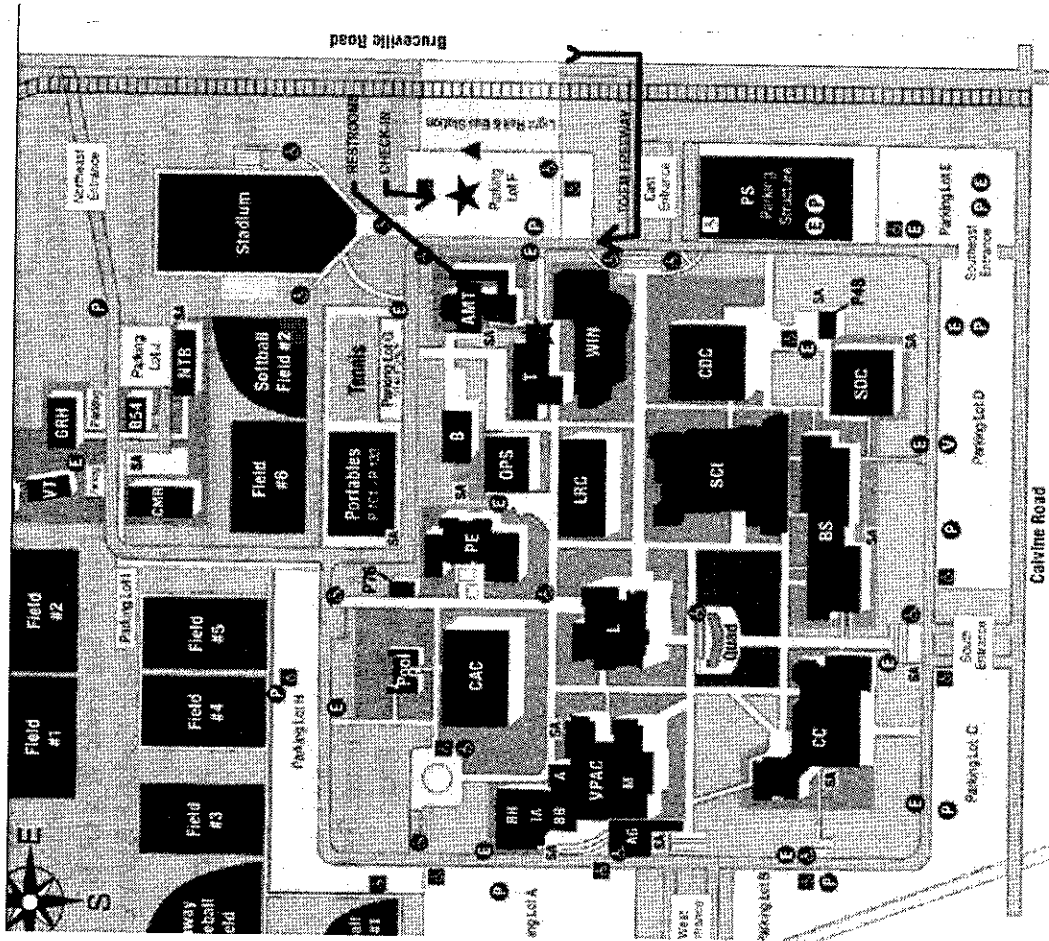
