

TRACS APRIL 13-14 2024 UKI – WOODLAND CA – RV INFO.

Gate Hours: The main gate is open as follows

Friday: 8 a.m. – 9 p.m. (and no we cannot have it opened any earlier)

Saturday/Sunday: 7 a.m. – 9 p.m.

Fair maintenance are the only ones that have the keys to the main gate so be cognizant of your time if you leave the fairgrounds. If you have any questions during the show on this, please come talk to me.

If you arrive prior to the gate being opened, please wait in the outer parking lot. If maintenance is late in opening, please be patient. TRACS has no control over this.

Returning to fairgrounds after 9 p.m. – (See attached map) if you find that you are not able to return prior to the main gates being locked you will need to come to the **main gate** and call me at 916 501-8319.

PARKING PASSES: When you enter the show site, a box with your parking pass will be set up in front of the building where the road splits. Please stop and pick yours up.

FRIDAY - Set up and Fun Runs

If you are not part of set up or a key worker, you may not enter the show site until **3:00 PM** - please wait in the outer parking lot until then

Otherwise:

10:00 TRACS trailers arrive

11:30 Exhibitors helping with setup may arrive

12:30 Unload trailers and Ring Setup Begins

3:00 General exhibitors not helping with setup may arrive

5:00 Fun Runs begin

Please refer to the attached map for available RV/tent spaces:

If you are a **key worker**, we have specific areas reserved (areas marked with a box) – there are some key worker spots that are specifically assigned. If it's not your name, then please do not park there.

If you are **not** a key worker, the map will also show general areas (Red) where electrical hookups are available. It is first come first serve.

Electrical:

The fairgrounds have added some new 50-amp hookups. Most of the remaining hookups are also 50 amps. If you need 30-amp please bring an adapter/reducer with you. Also, you may be asked to share a 50 amp so an adapter that will split the 1 50-amp into 2 30-amps would also be handy to have. It would also be prudent to bring an RV extension cord in case you need that little extra to reach the hookup.

There are quite a few 110 hookups available throughout the fairgrounds – some are standalone plugs and the majority are on the same poles as the 50-amps. Bring an extra extension cord to be sure you can reach.

Water:

While the fairgrounds have added electrical hookups they have also removed a number of water faucets. Be sure to fill you tanks before coming as we cannot guarantee a water hookup.

Like the electrical, the water faucets are not proprietary to any specific space. Bring splitters with you and be ready to share with you neighbor.

Showers:

The fairgrounds have not had showers for several years.
