

Information for Overnigheters at the TRACS USDAA Sept 22-23 2007 show

General Information

My name is Pam Richards. I am your **Camp Host**. I want your stay here to be pleasant so let me know if you have any problems and I will try to help you. My cell phone number is 916-580-8186. I will post a Camp Host sign by my motorhome.

Utility Connections ---- warning --- warning

This is a county fairgrounds and the electrical connections vary from a few 50's, some 30's and many 20's inside the grounds where the rings are. I have attempted to assign good sites that match your needs. But, you must bring converters so that you can use the electrical connection nearest your location. In addition, it could be necessary to use an extension cord. Water is available but frequently some distance from your site so you will need a long hose.

If you do not like the connections inside the fairgrounds there are sites with elec/water/sewer in an RV area outside the fairgrounds. These cost \$10 more than the sites inside the gates.

Check In

We will have directions at the entrance so you can locate me and receive your assigned spot. All overnigheters must have assigned spots.

Permits

You will be given a permit(s) that you must display in the window of your vehicle(s) during your stay. Each towed or towing vehicle will be given a permit.

Friday Arrival times are: 3pm - 8pm after 8pm follow directions at the entrance
Gates are closed and locked at 10 pm

Saturday Arrivals

Contact me at the fairgrounds and I will direct you to your assigned spot.

Traffic Movement

Only authorized and permitted vehicles will be allowed to move on the grounds during show hours. All other vehicles must be parked outside until the show is completed for the day.

Showers

There are showers available. They will be marked on your map.

Parking Permits

You will receive your parking permit when you arrive. This must be displayed prominently in your window. Please do not cover this up. We will be checking vehicles.

Other Users of the Fairgrounds

There will be other activities on the fairgrounds during the weekend.

Being Good Neighbors

It is critical that we leave the grounds in as good a condition as when we found it.

Please pickup after your dog.

Dogs may not pee on any man made items or obstacles such as, garbage cans, fences, light posts etc.
