From the North:

and from the Sacramento area take I-5 for about 17 miles North of Sacramento. Take exit 537-Main Street-towards Hwy 113/Woodland. Turn left onto East Main St. at the end of the off-ramp. Continue about a mile and turn left onto East St. Continue about 1/2 mile and turn left onto Gum Ave. Take first right into the Yolo County Fairgrounds driveway.

From the South:

and from the Bay area take I-80 for about 60 miles north of The Bay Area. Take Hwy 113 North exit to Woodland. Continue about 10 miles to exit 36 - Gibson Rd. Turn left onto Gibson . Take the first right onto Matmor Rd. Continue about 1/2 mile and take a left onto Gum Ave. After about 1/2 mile turn left into Yolo County Fairgrounds driveway.

Concessions

A caterer will have lunch available for purchase at the trial.

Set-up Information

Trial will be run rain or shine. There is ample room for crating, tents, and chairs outdoors. Please be advised to bring proper equipment to shade your dog or otherwise shelter your dog in case of inclement weather. Please remember to provide enough water for yourself and your dog(s).

Overnight/RV parking is by advance arrangement only and in designated areas only. See the RV form elsewhere in this test schedule.

Competitors are welcome to set up **Friday, Sep 14th, after 3:00 p.m.** Competitor assumes all risk of leaving items overnight. TRACS will not be responsible for any loss or damage to items at the show site. If you arrive prior to 3PM you may park/wait in the parking lot.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Class Descriptions

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. Once a competitor has earned a qualifying score with a dog in a Veterans class, the dog is no longer eligible to enter that class in the Championship or Performance Programs when a Veterans class is offered. Veterans Pairs Relay

This non-titling non-qualifying class is for dogs that are eligible to enter USDAA Veterans titling classes, who are not otherwise entered in any pairs class on the day they are entered in this class. Entering this class has no affect on the dog's future eligibility to enter titling pairs relay classes.

This class is run on the Masters/PIII Pairs Relay course, with the equipment set to Veterans specifications (vet jump heights, no spread jumps, vet Aframe height), judged and scored with Masters Pairs Relay rules. There is no SCT for the class since the class is non-qualifying.

Dogs entering this class must specify a veteran dog partner on the entry form, and the partner may be any jump height (vet pairs is not divided into open and mini divisions). NO DRAW ENTRIES will be accepted for this class: you must specify your partner on the entry form.

Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

Prizes & Awards

Titling Class Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each competition level at each jump height. 1st through 4th place ribbons for Mini and Open divisions for each of the Pairs Relay. 1st through 4th place ribbons for the entire Vet Pairs class. A maroon rosette for a qualifying score in all classes that apply; a black and maroon rosette for Master super-Q snooker scores.

Rosettes and title pins will be awarded to anyone earning a versatility title at this event (AD/PD, AAD/APD, MAD/MPD, ADCH/PDCH). Flat ribbons will be awarded to anyone titling in an individual class (SJ, PS1, AJ, PS2, JM, PJ3, etc).

Tournament Awards

* Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix: Rosettes will be awarded to Grand Prix and PGP qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height. In addition, the first place qualifying handler/dog team in each height class shall earn a regional "bye" voucher good for any 2013 regional GP/PGP class.

* STEEPLECHASE and SPEED JUMPING: Rosettes awarded to Steeplechase and PSJ qualifying scores. Prize money for Round 2 placements shall be computed based on 30% of the total entry fees for all jump heights collectively (in each class). Such money is distributed among eligible finalists according to the payout schedule below. If a finalist position is not filled for any reason, that prize money shall be forfeited.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).
