

Thank you for entering our USDAA Agility trial at the Yolo County Fairgrounds on Apr 12-14, 2019. If you have anything to change, email Holly Newman at <u>holly@agilepooch.com</u> or call/text 707-696-7623. There are 300-450 runs each day with 110 dogs entered, so we should end at a reasonable time on all three days.

GENERAL and SITE INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS: East on Interstate 80: Interstate 80 East to Woodland off ramp (Hwy.113). Take Gibson Rd. turn off. Turn left onto Gibson Rd. At Matmor signal turn right. Go to Gum Ave. (stop sign). Turn left onto Gum Avenue and proceed west to main entrance of fair. South on Interstate 5: Interstate 5 take Hwy. 113

(Main Street). Stay on 113 and take Gibson Road turn off. Turn right at Matmor signal and go to Gum Ave. Turn left onto Gum and proceed west to the main entrance.

North on Interstate 5: Take Interstate 5 North and take the E. Main Hwy 113 off ramp, turn left and follow E. Main street thru town. Turn left on East Street. Go to Gum Ave. and turn left. Go through the front entrance of the fairgrounds.

<u>CLEAN UP/MIND YOUR DOGS!</u> We must clean-up and BAG all poop (it is in the contract we will be fined if this is not done). Also do not allow dogs to urinate on trash cans or ANY structure!!!

<u>SITE SECURITY</u> - Be aware that the fairground gates will NOT be locked at any time, and the competitor assumes all risk of leaving items overnight. TRACS will not be responsible for any loss or damage to items at the show site. Things have been stolen at this site in the past. We recommend you secure or remove valuable items in your crating area overnight.

RV PARKING

Advance arrangement only (see Premium). Spaces on the fence next to the restrooms are reserved for Trial Committee/Key Workers. All other spaces are first-come, first-served. If you have any questions, contact <u>holly@agilepooch.com</u>.

IMPORTANT NOTE: As of Sun 4/7, there are no restrictions for RV parking due to lawn conditions. We will send a notice if that changes.

DAY PARKING

Parking is allowed in the interior of the fairgrounds. You will be directed AWAY from designated RV spots: please be considerate! Further, anyone parked beyond the split driveway next to the rings may NOT MOVE THEIR VEHICLE while the trial is running (assume 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.). If you anticipate needing to move your vehicle during these hours, you should instead park in the area immediately to the left after you enter the gate, before you get to the rings.

Parking is free in designated "Client Parking" spaces.

Please note: They must wear panties at all times around the rings (including when running). They must crate in an area other than the competition lawn. Please minimize the amount of time spent around the rings so as not to distract other dogs. They will run in order (not at the end). Please note "BIS" on gate sheets so that other handlers can move up if they have concerns. <u>MULLIGAN RUNS!!!</u> We've decided to experiment with USDAA's new Mulligan offering (<u>https://bit.ly/2WUESNq</u>). Details (subject to change at each daily briefing):
 SCORING, QUESTIONS, POSTING: Scores will be displayed on monitors in each ring and posted in the Results binders after each class is completed. Please check your results as soon as possible so we can resolve any questions you may have before the judge forgets your run. WORKERS: We are totally indebted to those who step up to help out! There will be whiteboards ringside on which you can sign up whenever you are available to help keep the trial moving. Every class you work will earn you tickets for our awesome Workers Raffle. If your Crew Chief doesn't give you one, don't be shy—ask for it! FOOD: Just in case the raffle isn't enough incentive, lunch will be provided for workers each day. No other food is available for purchase on-site. NOTE: there will be no morning coffee/treats. 			 1 ticket per dog per day. Tickets will be issued at the morning briefing. If you miss the briefing, get your ticket from Katrina/Roger. \$5/run, cash only, exact change preferred Offered for all classes EXCEPT Misc, Gamb, Pairs, and Sunday Snooker/Jumpers Sign up process (sheets will be posted): Sign up ASAP after your "real" run and before the last dog has run (unless, of course, you're the last dog). Present payment to the Masters ring scoretable (even if you're in the St/Adv ring) and your ticket will be stamped. Report to the gate as soon as the class ends. Mulligans will be run in the same height order. If you aren't there when your dog's name is called or you don't have your stamped ticket, you forfeit the run. IMPORTANT NOTE: This is new to all of us, so we're working out the kinks. Honor system is key. If you want to this to continue, please work with us to make it successful!
