

Thank you for entering our USDAA Agility trial at the Yolo County Fairgrounds on Sept 13-15, 2019. Move ups will be accepted until 6PM on Monday, Sept 9, 2019. If you have anything to change, email Holly Newman at holly@agilepooch.com or call/text 707-696-7623.

There are 350-450 runs each day with 102 dogs entered, so we should end at a reasonable time on all three days.

<u>CLEAN UP/MIND YOUR DOGS!</u> We must cleanup and BAG all poop (it is in the contract - we will be fined if this is not done). Also do not allow dogs to urinate on trash cans or ANY structure!!!

<u>WORKERS</u>: We are totally indebted to those who step up to help out! There will be whiteboards ringside on which you can sign up whenever you are available to help keep the trial moving. Every class you work will earn you tickets for our awesome Workers Raffle. If your Crew Chief doesn't give you one, don't be shy—ask for it!

<u>FOOD</u>: Just in case the raffle isn't enough incentive, lunch will be provided for workers each day. There will also be coffee/treats in the morning. No other food is available for purchase on-site.

<u>SCORING</u>, <u>QUESTIONS</u>, <u>POSTING</u> - Scores will be displayed on monitors in each ring and posted in the Results binders after each class is completed. Please check your results as soon as possible so we can resolve any questions you may have before the judge forgets your run.

<u>MOVE-UPS</u> - If you earn a title on Friday or Saturday and want to move up for the next day, please sign up on the move-up sheet before the end of the day.

RUNNING ORDERS, RESULTS: Both will be posted at www.agiltracs.org. The former by Tues 9/10 and the latter by Wed 9/18.

<u>SITE SECURITY</u> - Be aware that the fairground gates will NOT be locked at any time, and the competitor assumes all risk of leaving items overnight. TRACS will not be responsible for any loss or damage to items at the show site. Things have been stolen at this site in the past. We recommend you secure or remove valuable items in your crating area overnight.

<u>DIRECTIONS</u>: East on Interstate 80: Interstate 80 East to Woodland off ramp (Hwy.113). Take Gibson Rd. turn off. Turn left onto Gibson Rd. At Matmor signal turn right. Go to Gum

Ave. (stop sign). Turn left onto Gum Avenue and, proceed west to main entrance of fair. South on

Interstate 5: Interstate 5 take Hwy. 113 (Main Street). Stay on 113 and take Gibson Road turn off. Turn right at Matmor signal and go to Gum Ave. Turn left onto Gum and proceed west to the main entrance.

North on Interstate 5: Take Interstate 5 North and take the E. Main Hwy 113 off ramp, turn left and follow

E. Main street thru town. Turn left on East Street. Go to Gum Ave. and turn left. Go through the front entrance of the fairgrounds.

#### RV PARKING

Advance arrangement only (see Premium). Spaces on the fence next to the restrooms are reserved for Trial Committee/Key Workers. All other spaces are first-come, first-served. If you have any questions, contact holly@aqilepooch.com.

#### DAY PARKING

Parking is allowed in the interior of the fairgrounds. You will be directed AWAY from designated RV spots: please be considerate! Further, anyone parked beyond the split driveway next to the rings may NOT MOVE THEIR VEHICLE while the trial is running (approximately between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.). If you anticipate needing to move your vehicle during these hours, you should instead park in the area immediately to the left after you ether the gate, before you get to the rings.

12:30PM RV's may start arriving. Please review details and restrictions above. Set-up helpers may arrive and mark their crating spots (with the understanding that if they guess wrong, they may be asked to move).

1:00PM Set-up starts (course-building)
