AGILITY GATE: Yes! The access code is the trial date 1028.

FOOD: TRACS will be providing make your own sandwiches, chips and cookies. Lunch will be provided for our key workers, full-time workers and anyone bringing a side dish. Let Sharon Murphy <u>slmreo@sbcglobal.net</u> know what you are brining.

<u>WATER:</u> We'll have water for all in 5-gal spigotted jugs: BRING YOUR OWN BOTTLE TO FILL! Be green!

WORKERS: Whiteboards will be ringside at each ring where everyone else can sign up on day-of, for which we will be deeply in your debt. BITCHES IN SEASON

Are allowed at this event, provided they wear sanitary britches the entire time they are in populated areas (pottying, around the rings, in the rings while running).

DIRECTIONS:

East on Interstate 80: Interstate 80 East to Woodland off ramp (Hwy.113). Take Gibson Rd. turn off. Turn left onto Gibson Rd. At Matmor signal turn right. Go to Gum Ave. (stop sign). Turn left onto Gum Avenue and, proceed west to main entrance of fair. South on Interstate 5: Interstate 5 take Hwy. 113 (Main Street). Stay on 113 and take Gibson Road turn off. Turn right at Matmor signal and go to Gum Ave. Turn left onto Gum and proceed west to the main entrance.

North on Interstate 5: Take Interstate 5 North and take the E. Main Hwy 113 off ramp, turn left and follow E. Main street thru town. Turn left on East Street. Go to Gum Ave. and turn left. Go through the front entrance of the fairgrounds.

FRIDAY SETUP TIMELINE

11AM - RV's may arrive

<u>11AM - Ring set-up starts</u>. Competitors are very welcome to come then and help set up AND get preferential crating.

<u>3PM - General competitor set up</u>. If you show up before 2PM and are NOT helping with set-up at that time, then you will be invited to please wait until 2PM.

FAIRGROUNDS ACCESS/GATE IS CLOSED/LOCKED

<u>OVERNIGHT!</u> If you arrive after 9PM, you'll need to call <u>Sandy to let you in.</u> See the below GATE HOURS section on what to do after hours. Competitors assume all risk of leaving items overnight. TRACS will not be responsible for any loss or damage to items at the show site.

DAY PARKING - Parking is allowed in the interior of the fairgrounds, by the barns south of the starters/advanced ring. You will be directed AWAY from designated RV spots: please be considerate! Further, anyone parked inside may NOT MOVE THEIR VEHICLE while the trial is running (approximately between the hours of 730 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.). If you anticipate needing to move your vehicle during these hours, you should instead park in the main parking lot outside the fairgrounds front gate.

<u>RV PARKING</u> – Is by advance arrangement only, contact <u>kek@bumpsays.com</u>.

When you arrive, check in with Sandy Zajkowski for the permit you are required to display on your dashboard. RV spots are firstcome-first-served, with the exception of some marked spots that will be reserved for key workers. If you want to RV with your friends, make your own arrangements to have the first arrived in your group save adjacent spots for the rest of your crowd.
