will begin promptly.

Match Facilities

All obedience rings are outdoors on grass. All Obedience rings will have ring
stancions and double-strand ring tape.

If you require disabled parking or special accommodations, include a note to the
match secretary with your entry describing any assistance you may require.

There will be no food available on site.

Match Rules

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules
shall be allowed on the show grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash within the
show limits unless in the ring.

Catalogs will be provided for exhibitors.

Directions to Match Grounds

DIRECTIONS:

From Sacramento: Take I-80 west towards Dixon. Exit at Hwy 113 south
towards Dixon. Stay straight as the road curves left over I-80, following the signs
to stay on Hwy 113-S. Hwy 113 becomes First Street. Follow First St for a couple
of miles, passing through downtown Dixon. The fairgrounds are three blocks past
downtown on your left.

From Bay Area: Take Hwy I-80 east towards Sacramento. Exit at the Dixon
Avenue/A Street and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fair-
grounds are three blocks south on your left.

FOR ALL: Once you see the fairgrounds, go past the office and main entrance
drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds. The agility site will be
clearly in view as your enter the fairgrounds.

Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles

Even with the windows rolled down two inches or more, the heat can
become intense and cause brain damage! The club will not be
responsibile for damage to cars resulting from the rescue of overheated
animals!

Obedience Entry Fees

First Class in which dog is entered \$12.00
Each additional regular class for same dog\$ 6.00

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or when limits are reach, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by the Veterinarian, or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (includingl but not limited to extreme heat, snowstorms, or hurricanes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entry fees will be made.

Closing Date: May 14, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed and must be at the address of the Match Secretary. No telegraph, telephone, faxed, unsigned or incomplete entries will be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Checks returned by the bank for non-sufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25 collection fee will be added to the amount of each check returned.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Please type or hand-write neatly on entries. Email acknowledgement of acceptance of entry shall occur promptly after receipt of entry. Formal confirmation and judging schedule will arrive by both by US mail and email (when email contact provided). I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
