A <u>separate entry form</u> must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Wait List: Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 11:30 pm on December 17, 2021. Any entries withdrawn by 6:00 pm on December 23, 2021 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund less a \$5 processing fee will be issued to the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on December 23, 2021 will receive a full refund.

- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or have anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and must list "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) for the breed name on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, the exhibitor must provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No."
- Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- > No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- EXCEPT IN A WAIT LIST SITUATION, there will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler as confirmed by a veterinarian's or doctor's letter/email. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing (email is acceptable, but MUST be sent return receipt to confirm we did receive it) prior to the trial. Bitches in season will be refunded their full entry fee.
