SHOW SITE: This show will be held outdoors on grass. Ring dimensions will be 100' x 120' per ring. The site is the Dixon May Fairgrounds, 655 S. First St., Dixon, CA.95620

AWARDS

- Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular class and jump height.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing a title or earning a "Double Q" from the Excellent B classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH. If you anticipate you may complete your MACH at our trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- A Cash prize for each ISC Class will be offered. In addition, a "High Combined" rosette and cash prize will be awarded to the dog with the best combined score from each jump height in the ISC Standard and ISC JWW Class.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- This event is open to all AKC-registered (including dogs from the Miscellaneous Class) dogs 12 months of age and older. Blind, lame, aggressive dogs, and bitches in season are ineligible to compete.
- Dogs may wear flat buckle or rolled leather collars; but there shall be no attachments, hanging or otherwise, allowed on the collar.
- No food, toys, or other training aids will be permitted in the course area. Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring.
- Running order will be determined by a random draw, and handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season. In these cases entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided that the trial secretary is notified prior to the trial. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this event cannot be held or completed for any cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.** The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check (this is the amount charged by our bank for returned checks). Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- Please clean up after your dog. Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals!
- Please note: **TRACS has rented only a portion of the Fairgrounds.** Please respect the boundary, parking and RV/Camping signs.

Any RVs arriving prior to Friday, May 27th risk having to move to their assigned Friday am. If arriving Friday, please do not arrive prior to 10:00 am

Just a heads up for planning purposes: With the exception of Trial Committee personnel, others by permit and RVs with their associated tow vehicles, there will be **NO** competitor parking inside the inner fenced area of Dixon Fairgrounds. You will be able to drive in to unload, but you will have to move your vehicle to the outer parking lots no later than noon on Friday and 7:30 am the other days (this time may adjust earlier if necessary). There are two lots: the one you drive through when you turn off First Street into the Fairgrounds, and then one across First Street from the Main entrance. Neither lot is very far away.

RVs will not be permitted into the Fairgrounds prior to 10:00 am on Friday, May 27th. Any arriving prior to that time will be staged in the parking area just off First Street. Since all RV spaces are pre-assigned, you don't need to worry about not having a space and no one else will park in your space as each RV will be escorted to their assigned space.

Additionally, unless you have volunteered to assist in site set up, there will be no set ups permitted prior to the time listed in your confirmation letter. You **MUST** give the Show Committee time to get there and set the show up. We want to make sure the infrastructure is set before the land rush begins. There will be some areas normally used for crating that may have other functions (catering, awards, etc) planned to be there.

This step has been taken to reduce congestion, improve air flow and ensure emergency vehicles and other users of the Fairgrounds can have access when needed.

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES:

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent Class.

NOTE: ISC rule changes have been made, effective January 1, 2002 and will apply to this trial.

Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>)

Jump Heights: The ISC shall be split into three (3) separate categories:

Mini – for dogs measuring 13 ¾" and/or less at the withers; jump 14"

Midi – for dogs measuring over 13 ¾" but 16 7/8" or less; jump 18"

Maxi – for dog measuring over 16 7/8"; jump 26"

Eligibility: This class is open ONLY to dogs that are eligible to compete in BOTH the Excellent Standard class AND the Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Class.

Agility Site and Accommodations

Dixon May Fairgrounds, 655 South First Street, Dixon CA 95620

The site is outdoors on grass. There is limited shade. Parking is in designated parking lots only. There is no competitor parking inside the Dixon Fairgrounds. There will be three rings.

Directions from I-80 west: take 113 South towards Dixon. Stay straight as the road curves left over 80, follow the signs to stay on 113-S. 113 becomes 1st street. Follow First St for a couple miles passing through downtown Dixon, the fairgrounds are three blks past downtown on your left.

Directions I-80 east: take the Dixon Avenue / A Street exit and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are three blocks south on your left side. Go past the office and main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds. The agility site will be clearly in view as you enter the fairgrounds.
