IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS:

- **If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation information and judging schedule. Please make sure the Trial Secretary's email address: (agiltervs@comcast.net) is allowed by your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address.**
- There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial.
- Move ups will be accepted until **noon on Monday, May 22, 2006**. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site within 30 minutes of the end of each day's trial.
- We will accept copies of your jump height cards. Please send them with your entry. If you have entered a previous TRACS AKC trial and submitted a card, it is on file. PLEASE DO NOT send another copy.
- ENTRY FEES (PER DOG, PER DAY): \$18.00 – 1ST Class (includes \$3 AKC Recording Fee); \$8.00 – 2ND Class
\$ 8.00 – ISC Class
- SHOW SITE: This show will be held outdoors on grass. Ring dimensions will be 120' by 100' per ring.

AWARDS

- Rosettes and a prize will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing any title or earning a "Double Q" from the Excellent B classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH. If you anticipate you may complete your MACH at our trial, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary.
- ISC – rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 6th place dogs with qualifying scores in each jump height plus a prize for 1st place. In addition, a "High Combined" rosette and cash prize will be awarded to the dog with the best combined score from each jump height in the ISC Standard and ISC JWW Class.

- NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or breeds eligible for registration that have obtained an ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Running order will be determined by a random draw, and handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified prior to the trial. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check (this is the amount charged by our bank for returned checks). Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- Please clean up after your dog. Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- The nearest 24 hour Emergency Veterinarian: UC Davis Veterinary Teaching Hospital (530) 752-1393.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The club does agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

FOOD:

Dannie's Catering will be on site for purchasing hot breakfasts and lunches. Workers will receive TRACS Bucks which can be used towards lunch, with vendors or towards future TRACS trials.

TRACS will be serving complimentary continental style breakfast each morning **until 10:00 AM**. This will include juice, muffins and fruit. Refreshments will be available to all workers throughout the day.

AGILITY TRIAL SITE AND ACCOMMODATIONS

SITE: Dixon May Fairgrounds, This site is outdoors on grass-with limited shade. There will be three 120' x 100' rings.

DIRECTIONS:

From Sacramento: Take I-80 west towards Dixon. Exit at Hwy 113 south towards Dixon. Stay straight as the road curves left over I-80, following the signs to stay on Hwy 113-S. Hwy 113 becomes First Street. Follow First St for a couple of miles, passing through downtown Dixon. The fairgrounds are three blocks past downtown on your left.

From Bay Area: Take Hwy I-80 east towards Sacramento. Exit at the Dixon Avenue/A Street and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are three blocks south on your left.

FOR ALL: Once you see the fairgrounds, go past the office and main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds. The agility site will be clearly in view as you enter the fairgrounds.

RV PARKING: Is by advance reservation ONLY! All RV parking reservations must be made by sending in the enclosed form to Kathie Leggett (address is on the form) and **ALL overnights will be given an ASSIGNED parking spot.** Space is limited. RV's arriving after 12 noon on Friday, must enter via the back gate on Chestnut Street.

REGULAR TITLING CLASS

Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an agility title.

Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

PREFERRED TITLING CLASSES

Open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in AKC Agility Trial regulations. Dogs may be entered in either Preferred class or the Regular class at any trial. The dog must be entered ONLY in Preferred or Regular classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. So, if you want to enter your dog in Preferred classes on the first day, you must also enter Preferred on all other days.

Novice – All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level regardless of the previous titles.

Novice Preferred is NOT split into A and B divisions.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice Preferred or Open Preferred titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent Preferred class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open Preferred title, but have not completed the Excellent Preferred title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have completed the Excellent Preferred title.

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES:

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Jump Heights: The ISC shall be split into three (3) separate categories:

Mini – for dogs measuring 13 ¾" and/or less at the withers; jump 14"

Midi – for dogs measuring over 13 ¾" but 16 7/8" or less; jump 18"

Maxi – for dog measuring over 16 7/8"; jump 26"

Eligibility: This class is open ONLY to dogs that are eligible to compete in BOTH the Excellent Standard class AND the Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Class.
