# NEW RULES REGARDING JUMP HEIGHT CARDS!!!!

In order to expedite day-of-trial check in, the AKC supports having exhibitors include a photocopy of their jump height card with their entry form, however, the AKC no longer allows file copies for trials that are not administered by the AKC's new online trial system. Therefore <u>YOU MUST INCLUDE A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR JUMP HEIGHT CARD</u> if you want to skip check-in, no matter how long you have been competing at our trials. Sorry, and thank you very much for understanding.

## NEW AKC LEASH RESTRICTIONS START MARCH 1, 2009

Dogs must enter and exit the ring with the leash attached to the dog's collar or harness, or in the case of a slip lead, with the noose completely around the dog's neck, with the other end of the leash held by the handler. Any entry or exit chutes added to the ring for the ease of getting dogs in and out of the ring are not considered to be part of the ring. Clubs must provide a leash holder or a container for the leash runner to place the leash in or on, which can easily be located by the handler near the ring exit. Leashes or slip leads may not be hung on the ring barrier nor placed on the ground. There is a Mandatory Excusal of any dog whose owner violates the regulation.

## **IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS**

- If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation
  information and judging schedule. Please make sure the Trial Secretary's email address: (tervteam@comcast.net) is allowed by
  your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address.
- Move ups will be accepted until 6 pm Monday, May 18, 2009. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form
  is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site within 15 minutes of the last run of each day.

ENTRY FEES (Per Dog, Per Day): \$16.00 - 1<sup>ST</sup>Class / \$14.00 ea.- 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> class / \$8.00 - ISC Classes (includes AKC Recording Fees of \$3 per run).

SHOW SITE: This show will be held outdoors on grass. Ring dimensions will be 100' X 120' per ring.

# AWARDS

- Rosettes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height.
- Prizes valued between \$5 and \$2 will be awarded to all dogs placing first through fourth in their class/jump height.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing a title or earning a "Double Q" from the Excellent B classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH. PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary if you think you will complete your MACH.
- ISC rosettes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place dogs with qualifying scores in each jump height plus a prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place. In addition, a "High Combined" rosette and cash prize will be awarded to the dog with the best combined score from each jump height in the ISC Standard and ISC JWW Class.

# NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained an ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- > Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- > No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing prior to the trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial. Breeder, Sire and Dam information is required if available. If your dog is AKC registered (except ILP) this information is available.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- Handlers of all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of a class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring. There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial. No umbrellas permitted on course during walk throughs.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fee paid will be made.
- > All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet of open toe shoes.
- > Please clean up after your dog. Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- > The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
- CLOSING DATE CLARIFICATION Closing date for this event is May 1<sup>st</sup> at 6pm. Your physical entry and fee must be in the Trial Secretary's <u>hands</u> by this date and time in order for your entry to be valid. If needed, you can send your entry by overnight service to arrive by the closing date (specifying "no signature required"). Examples of invalid entries that will be returned to sender due to being too late:
  - ✓ Entrants who get their entries postmarked with the closing date's date and then mailed.
  - Entrants who email the Trial Secretary on the day of closing asking if it's okay to fax or email their entry-fee to follow.
  - Entrants who put their entry into the mailbox one day before closing date "because it usually makes it" whose entries then take two days.
  - ✓ Entrants who send their entry with postage due or signature required.

## AGILITY TRIAL SITE AND ACCOMMODATIONS

**<u>SITE:</u>** Dixon May Fairgrounds, This site is outdoors on grass-with limited shade. There will be three 100' x 120' rings.

#### DIRECTIONS:

From Sacramento: Take I-80 west towards Dixon. Exit at Hwy 113 south towards Dixon. Stay straight as the road curves left over I-80, following the signs to stay on Hwy 113-S. Hwy 113 becomes First Street. Follow First St for a couple of miles, passing through downtown Dixon. The fairgrounds are three blocks past downtown on your left.

From Bay Area: Take Hwy I-80 east towards Sacramento. Exit at the Dixon Avenue/A Street and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are three blocks south on your left.

FOR ALL: Once you see the fairgrounds, go past the office and main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds. The agility site will be clearly in view as your enter the fairgrounds.

RV PARKING: Is by advance reservation <u>ONLY</u>! All RV parking reservations must be made by sending in the enclosed form to Lisa Kretner and ALL overnighters will be given an <u>ASSIGNED</u> parking spot. Space is limited. RVs/Campers arriving after 7:30 am on Friday will not be parked until after the end of the last class of the day. # ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: REGULAR TITLING CLASS

- Novice A For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an agility title.
- Novice B For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title and for agility judges.
- Open For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.
- Excellent A For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.
- Excellent B For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: PREFERRED TITLING CLASSES

Dogs may be entered in either Preferred class or the Regular class at any trial. The dog must be entered ONLY in Preferred or Regular classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. So, if you want to enter your dog in Preferred classes on the first day, you must also enter Preferred on all other days.

- Novice All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level regardless of the previous titles. Novice Preferred is NOT split into A and B divisions.
- Open For dogs that have acquired the Novice Preferred or Open Preferred titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent Preferred class.
- Excellent A For dogs that have acquired the Open Preferred title, but have not completed the Excellent Preferred title.
- Excellent B For dogs that have completed the Excellent Preferred title.

# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES:

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The

total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<u>http://www.akc.org</u>).

Jump Heights: The ISC shall be split into three (3) separate categories:

Mini – for dogs measuring  $13\frac{3}{4}$ " and/or less at the withers; jump 14" Midi – for dogs measuring over  $13\frac{3}{4}$ " but 16 7/8" or less; jump 18"

Maxi – for dog measuring over 16 7/8"; jump 26"

Eligibility: T his class is open ONLY to dogs t hat are eligible to compete in <u>BOTH</u> the Exc ellent Standard Class <u>AND</u> the Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Class.

# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: F.A.S.T.- Fifteen and Send Time

The focus of the FAST class is to test the skill, timing and distance work involved in a game of strategy and point accumulation.

- Novice A For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an agility title.
- Novice B For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title and for agility judges.
- Open For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent A class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent A title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

#### HEIGHT DIVISION CHART

Regular class dogs may run in a higher height division, but not a lower one. Preferred class dogs <u>MAY NOT</u> run in a higher height division. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. *In no case may a dog be moved <u>down</u> in height based on a judge's measurement at a trial.*

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their doq(s) measured prior to running.
