NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS

- If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation
 information and judging schedule. Please make sure the Trial Secretary's email address: (<u>kathie@touchngoagility.com</u>) is
 allowed by your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email
 address.
- Move ups will be accepted until 8 pm Monday, May 23, 2011. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form
 is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site within 15 minutes of the last run of each day.

ENTRY FEES (Per Dog, Per Day): \$16.00 - 1STClass / \$16.00 ea.- 2nd & 3rd class except ISC Classes are only \$8.00 (includes AKC Recording Fees of \$3 per run). All fees must be paid in U.S. funds only-by cash or check. Sample Fees: STD + JWW + FAST = \$48.00 Or JWW + STD + ISC = \$40.00

<u>AWARDS</u>

- Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height.
- Prizes valued between \$2 and \$5 will be awarded to all dogs placing first through fourth in their class/jump height.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing a title or earning a "Double Q" from the Excellent B classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH. PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary if you anticipate you may complete your MACH at our trial.
- ISC rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 6th place dogs with qualifying scores in each jump height plus a prize for 1st place. In addition, a "High Combined" rosette and cash prize will be awarded to the dog with the best combined score from each jump height in the ISC Standard and ISC JWW Classes on Sat and Sun only.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Wait List: Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 8:00 pm on May 16, 2011. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 8:00 pm on May 16, 2011 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund less a \$5 processing fee will be issued to the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 8:00 pm on May 24, 2011 will receive a full refund.

- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or ha anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and must list "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) for the breed name on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, the exhibitor must provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No."
- Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing prior to the trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry-PLEASE PRINT; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.

- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. \geq Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- \geq Handlers of all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of a class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring. There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial. No umbrellas permitted on course during walk throughs.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or ≻ children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fee paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area. \geq
- ≻ Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
- \triangleright Please clean up after your dog. Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- \triangleright DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- On Call Veterinarian: UC Davis Veterinary Teaching Hospital (530) 752-1393. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to \triangleright assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AGILITY TRIAL SITE DIRECTIONS AND ACCOMMODATIONS

DIRECTIONS:

From Sacramento: Take I-80 west towards Dixon. Exit at Hwy 113 south towards Dixon. Stay straight as the road curves left over I-80, following the signs to stay on Hwy 113-S. Hwy 113 becomes First Street. Follow First St for a couple of miles, passing through downtown Dixon. The fairgrounds are three blocks past downtown on your left.

From Bay Area: Take Hwy I-80 east towards Sacramento. Exit at the Dixon Avenue/A Street and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are three blocks south on your left.

FOR ALL: Once you see the fairgrounds, go past the office and main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds. The agility site will be clearly in view as your enter the fairgrounds.

RV PARKING: Is by advance reservation ONLY! All RV parking reservations must be made by sending in the enclosed form to Pam Richards (address is on the form later in the Premium List) and ALL overnighters will be given an ASSIGNED parking spot. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: REGULAR TITLING CLASS

Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an agility title.

Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title and for agility judges.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: PREFERRED TITLING CLASSES

Dogs may be entered in either Preferred class or the Regular class at any trial. The dog must be entered ONLY in Preferred or Regular classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. So, if you want to enter your dog in Preferred classes on the first day, you must also enter Preferred on all other days.

 Novice All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level regardless of the previous titles. Novice Preferred is NOT split into A and B divisions.

 Open For dogs that have acquired the Novice Preferred or Open Preferred titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent Preferred class.

 Excellent A For dogs that have acquired the Open Preferred title, but have not completed the Excellent Preferred title.

 Excellent B For dogs that have completed the Excellent Preferred title.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: F.A.S.T.- Fifteen and Send Time

The focus of the FAST class is to test the skill, timing and distance work involved in a game of strategy and point accumulation.

Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an agility title.

Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title and for agility judges.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent A class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent A title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES:

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (http://www.akc.org).

Eligibility: This class is open <u>ONLY</u> to dogs that are eligible to compete in <u>BOTH</u> the Excellent Standard Class <u>AND</u> the Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Class.

Jump Heights:

The ISC shall be split into three (3) separate categories: Mini – for dogs measuring 13 ¾" and/or less at the withers; jump 14" Midi – for dogs measuring over 13 ¾" but 16 7/8" or less; jump 18" Maxi – for dog measuring over 16 7/8"; jump 26"

HEIGHT DIVISION CHART

Exhibitors may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes <u>must</u> compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; however they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present, **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

FOOD:

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> then their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
