INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in the regular AKC Excellent / Master class. Complete rules for the ISC are available form the AKC website (http://www.akc.org)

<u>Eligibility</u>: These classes are open to ANY LEVEL dog registered with AKC. For the Gold Rush Cup, there is no Preferred Divisions; dogs may be entered at their preferred jump height; however, they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the regular height. In other words: a dog measuring 21" would normally jump 20"; they may enter at their preferred 16" jump height, however, they will be scored with the 20" class

<u>Jump Heights</u>: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", and 20" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) or any dog entering the 24" jump high may use their clean run toward to required qualification towards entering WTT or EOTT. The FCI/ISC cutoff for those heights are as follows:

- Small (12" jump height) for dogs measuring $13\frac{3}{4}$ " or less at the withers
- Medium (16" jump height) for dogs measuring more than 13 ³/₄" but less than 16.88" at the withers
- Intermediate (20" jump height) for dogs measuring more than 16.88" but less than 18.89" at the withers.
- Large (24" jump height) for dogs measuring over 18.89" at the withers

World Team Tryouts (WTT) Qualifications: "Clean run" scores from the ISC Standard and ISC JWW may be used to fulfill the minimum requirements of 4 Std/4 JWW legs (i.e., 1 ISC Standard Q = 1 Regular Standard Q, and 1 ISC JWW Q = 1 Regular JWW Q). A "clean run" in ISC consists of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores as yardages are not calculated as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class. The height requirements are the same as stated above. All ISC class scores can be used – including, but not limited to the Regional World Team Qualifier event

ISC Combined Class Winners

At the Gold Rush Cup, the Regional WTT classes will be Round 1 (JWW) and Round 3 (Standard).

Combined scores from ISC Jumpers (Round 1 only) and ISC Standard (Round 2 only) classes at the Regional World Team Qualifier Events will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award. To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award the team must have a minimum of one clean ISC run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score.

The Combined Class winner from the 12, 16, 20 and 24 inch heights are invited to attend Team Tryouts. They do not need to fulfill the requirement of the 4/4 scores. The team must also send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility noted in this document (including an approved pedigree). The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award.

In no way does the club holding the Event ("Club"); the Event's Trial Chair; TRACS Officers; Trial Secretary; Event Committee (as defined in the Event premium); or Yolo County Fairgrounds warrant that COVID-19 infection will not occur through participation in the Event.

This agreement supplements the Agreement contained in the Event premium. By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 while participating in the Event, and that such exposure or infections may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, the Club, TRACS Club Officers, Trial Chair, Trial Secretary, Event Committee, Yolo County Fairgrounds and its personnel; and other Event participants. I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself (including, but not limited to personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense of any kind, that I may experience or incur in connection with my attendance at the Event ("Claims"). I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless, the Club; TRACS Officers; Trial Chair; Trial Secretary; Event Committee and their representatives; or Yolo County Fairgrounds and its personnel; of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Club; TRACS Officers; Trial Chair; Trial Secretary; Event Committee and their representatives; or Yolo County Fairgrounds and its personnel; whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in the Event.

I declare that I will not participate in or attend the Event if: (i) I test positive or presumptively positive for COVID-19 or am identified as a potential carrier of COVID-19 or similar communicable illness within 21 days of the Event date; (ii) I am in close contact with or care for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the Event date; (iii) I experience any symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19 or cold or flu-like symptoms within 21 days of the Event date (fever, cough, shortness of breath or other respiratory problems). I understand that if any of the above occur, I may not attend the Event and I may notify the Trial Secretary and receive a full refund.

I will follow all Club rules and requirements ("Rules") to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading COVID-19. The Rules are contained in the event premium and/or will be sent to me prior to the Event. As this situation continues to evolve, I understand the rules in the Event premium may change prior to the Event, and I will follow the latest Rules communicated to me prior to the Event. I will also fully cooperate with and follow any City, County and State guidelines, mandates, or orders that have jurisdiction in the area in which the Event is taking place ("Guidelines"). I understand that if I fail to follow the Rules and Guidelines, I may be expelled from the Event with no refund. If the Rules and Guidelines change between the time of my entry into the Event and the Event Date and I am not comfortable with such changes, I may withdraw from the event prior to the start of the Event and receive a full refund.

AGILITY TRIAL COVID-19 SAFETY PROCEDURES Yolo County Fairgrounds, Woodland, CA

The following set of rules and guidelines were developed using CDC, California State, Yolo County, and AKC Guidelines for the safety of our officials, volunteers, and exhibitors.

These guidelines may be modified if we receive new information from Federal, State, or County authorities. These changes may occur up until the date of the trials. Please make sure you download the latest version just prior to the event so you know what to expect on your trial day(s).

Participants must be responsible for their personal hygiene and health. Individuals must be responsible for maintaining physical distancing for themselves and their dogs in the competition area, in the dog walking areas, crating areas, RV parking, camping spaces, and parking lots. Anyone not following club listed/posted procedures while on the property will be asked to leave and, if an exhibitor, no refund will be given. Additional safety precautions are listed below:

- Face Coverings: As of 3/22, State/County mask guidelines are that masks are strongly recommended indoors and in crowds outdoors. TRACS is taking the conservative approach and requiring masks to be worn during all walkthroughs
- Masks must be worn anytime you are in the following areas if others are there and social distance cannot be maintained:
 - Scoring
 - Judges' Table
 - Awards
 - Raffle
 - Bathrooms
