MIXED HEIGHT / DIVISION ENTRIES

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch

A <u>separate entry form</u> must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. <u>Exceptions</u>: bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.
- No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.
- Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.
- Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

 Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and must list "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) for the breed name on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, the exhibitor must provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No."

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards must be measured before running, either by the judge of record, except 24"/24C dogs. However, if a VMO or AKC Agility Field Representative is on site, all dogs without height cards, INCLUDING 24"/24C dogs, need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog on the "*Dogs To Be Measured List*".

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

- FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
- Because this is a regular AKC trial, FEO is only available in the Time to Beat and FAST classes.
- Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare FEO through the Agility Gate app the day of the trial.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is
 committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not
 allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Masters). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the judge and the scribe.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

- Fix and Go On (FNG) is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.
- FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's
 performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation.
- This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.
- FNG will result in a non-qualifying score
- Exhibitors are not to signal they are using FNG the judge will signal the scribe appropriately.

You can turn in your move up as soon as the official results are posted. It really helps us out to get the move ups earlier in the day.
- Agility Gate App We will be using the Agility Gate app for the trial so you can keep track of where we are on your smart phone. Please go to https://agilitygate.com or your app store to download/update the app on the Thursday before the trial. If you download it before that, you may need to update again. ONLY TRACS KEYWORKER RVs will have pre-assigned spaces. All other RV parking inside the Fairgrounds will be first come, first served. You must still send in an Overnight Parking/Camping Form (found later in the premium) accompanied by payment. TRACS will issue Overnight Parking/Camping Permits that must be displayed while parked during the trial.

If you arrive before TRACS has had an opportunity to mark reserved RV spots, and you end up parked in a spot that has been reserved for a keyworker, you will be required to move.

An RV site map will be included with the Judging schedule so you will have some idea of what power is available in which locations and where water may be available.

There is an actual RV Park in the area between Gum Ave and the Chain Link gate (to your right as you drive in). To reserve a space there, you will NOT send in your RV reservation. This park is run/managed by the Fairgrounds. This Park has 30/50 amp power, water, and sewer. Cost here is \$45.00 / night. NOTE FOR DRY CAMPERS / Day Parking People: (whether you are in RV, Car, Van or Tent):

Neither Dry Campers nor Day Parking folks may not park/camp in any spot that has a power hookup.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WORLD TEAM QUALIFYING EVENT & THE RED POPPY INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC) CUP ENTRY INFORMATION

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (http://www.akc.org).

Eligibility:

- ISC classes are open to all dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials.
- There is no Preferred Option for ISC: dogs may enter at their preferred jump height; however, they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping their regular height. For example: 16" preferred dogs will be scored against 20" regular division dogs.
- Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC (this event is limited to Level 2 and 3). At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the information in this premium list may run any level. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

ISC EQUIPMENT NOTES:

The tire will be set at FCI height/width for the 12, 16, 20 and 24" jump heights.

Tire: The tire is measured to the center of the aperture

Large: 32" to center (20" measured at the bottom of the tire opening) Intermediate: 28" to center (16" measured at the bottom of the tire opening) Medium/Small: 22" to center (10" measured at the bottom of the tire opening)

Jump Heights:

- DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS,
- Only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) are eligible for the WTT Bye Award.
- Only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean runs towards meeting the WTT/EOTT Entry Qualification Requirements. You can find details on these qualifications at the following links:

The FCI / ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- Small (12" jump height) for dogs measuring 13 ³/₄" or less at the withers
- Medium (16" jump height) dog dogs measuring more then 13 ³/₄" and up / including to 16 7/8" at the withers
- Intermediate (20" jump height) for dogs measuring more than 16 7/8" and up to / including 18 7/8" at the withers
- Large (24" jump height) for dogs measuring over 18 7/8" at the withers.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WORLD TEAM QUALIFYING EVENT COMBINED CLASS AWARD

Combined scores from Nor Cal Regional ISC Agility and ISC Jumping classes at this event will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award and the World Team Tryouts Bye.

- To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award, a team must have a minimum of one clean run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score.
- If the winning dog in any given jump height does not meet the FCI jump heights, the award DOES NOT go to the first eligible dog.
- If no FCI-eligible dog meets the requirements for Combined Class Award, the Bye award is not given, however the TRACS-sponsored High Combined and Cash Award will be awarded.
- The Combined Class winners that meet the FCI jump height cut offs from the 12", 16", 20", and 24-inch height are invited to attend the 2024 AKC World Team Tryouts. No other performance requirements need to be met.
- The team does need to send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and must meet all the other basic eligibility (including an approved pedigree).
- The handler at WTT must be the same handler that won the Combined Award

THE RED POPPY ISC CUP

- DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs – see info in the Nor Cal Regional section above. Additionally, only those dogs may use their clean runs towards meeting the WTT/EOTT Entry Qualification Requirements. You can find details on these qualifications at the following links:

- The Red Poppy ISC Cup classes will be fit in/around the regular AKC trial classes. This means they will not be running back-to-back. There will be a delay between each round each day.
- Who Advances to the Final Round? 40% of qualifying scores in each jump height each round are eligible to compete in the Final round.
- All Level 2 classes qualifying scores may be used to meet qualifying criteria for both the World Team Tryouts (WTT) and European Open Team Tryouts (EOTT).
- The Level 3 Finals may NOT be used to meet the qualifying criteria for WTT or EOTT because not all dogs will be eligible for that round.
- Be sure to use the ISC Classes Entry Form to enter these classes (it is clearly different from the entry form for the regular trial classes).
