Kathie just put out the judging schedule to exhibitors, but I wanted to highlight some information that applies to people staying onsite

Gate Hours: The main gate is open/closes as follows

Thursday: 8:30 a.m. - 9 p.m.

Friday: 6 a.m. - 9 p.m.

Saturday: 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. black gates

3 p.m. - 9 p.m. exit and enter at the East Street Gate**

Sunday - Monday: 6 a.m. - 9 p.m.

**Saturday - please note that the black gates will be closed at 3 p.m. due to a public event being held in the nearby buildings.

If you arrive prior to the gate being opened, please wait in the outer parking lot. If maintenance is late in opening, please be patient. TRACS has no control over this.

Fair maintenance are the only ones that have the keys to the main gate so be cognizant of your time if you leave the fairgrounds. If you have any questions during the show on this, please come talk to me or Karey.

Returning to fairgrounds after 9 p.m. – (See attached map) if you find that you are not able to return prior to the main gates being locked you will need to use the emergency entrance gate off East Street. For after-hours assistance please contact Karey at 650 906-5146.

THURSDAY - set up day

If you are not on the list as part of set up you may not enter the show site until **2:00 PM** - please wait in the outer parking lot until then

Otherwise:

8:30 TRACS trailers arrive

9:00 those with RVs and helping with setup may arrive and set up your RV site

10:30 those helping with setup and without RVs may arrive and setup begins

2:00 General Exhibitors may arrive and setup

Parking Passes

Please stop at the little building that sits between the 2 roads and pick up your parking pass – please display in a prominent place on your rv/trailer or tow vehicle

Please refer to the attached map for available RV/tent spaces:

If you are a key worker, we have specific key worker areas reserved. Some sites within the key worker areas are reserved for specific people (marked with a YELLOW flag). Otherwise, the remaining key workers can choose their site within the reserved areas,

If you are not a key worker, the map will also show general areas (Red) where electrical hookups are available. It is first come first serve. (TRACS reserves the right to change the designation of a general area to a reserved key worker site).

Electrical:

The fairgrounds have mostly 50-amp hookups. If you need 30-amp please bring an adapter with you. Also, you may be asked to share a 50 amp so an adapter that will split the 1 50-amp into 2 30-amps would also be handy to have. It would also be prudent to bring an RV rated extension cord in case you need that little extra to reach the hookup.

There are quite a few 110 hookups available throughout the fairgrounds – some are standalone plugs and the majority are on the same poles as the 50-amps. Bring an extra extension cord to be sure you can reach.

Water:

While the fairgrounds have added electrical hookups, they have also removed several water faucets. Be sure to fill you tanks before coming as we cannot guarantee a water hookup.

Like the electrical, the water faucets are not proprietary to any specific space. Bring splitters with you and be ready to share with you neighbor.

Showers:

The fairgrounds have not had showers for several years.
