



**Welcome to the TRACS AKC Memorial Day Weekend Agility Trials; the 4th Red Poppy ISC Cup; and the Northern California Regional World Team Tryouts Qualifying Event
May 22, 23, 24, & 25, 2026
Yolo County Fairgrounds – Outdoors on grass

Thank you for entering our AKC Memorial Day Agility Trials. This is a preliminary judging schedule which is contingent upon move up entries that may not have been received yet.

Upon acceptance of your entry, whether you entered through the LabTested Online Entry Service or mailed your entry to me, you were emailed a TRACS entry confirmation. Please ensure you have read this confirmation carefully. Unless due to a Trial Secretary oversight, errors must be corrected **before** the day of the show. No additions, deletions, or changes may be made after closing except for move ups. If you have anything to change, email kathie@touchngoagility.com.

Move ups for Friday, May 22nd are accepted until Monday, May 18th, 2025 at 10:00 PM and must be in print (either letter or email). Although move ups for Saturday, Sunday and Monday will be taken until 15 minutes after the close of the day's event, please consider turning in your move up form as soon as you have confirmed your results.

AGILITY TRIAL SITE DIRECTIONS

DIRECTIONS:

From the Bay Area via I-80 East: Take I-80 East towards Sacramento. Exit I-80 onto CA-113 North (just past Dixon) towards Woodland for 8.7 miles. Take Exit 34, Road 25A. Follow Rd 25A for approximately .45 miles and turn right onto East Street. Follow East Street for 1.88 miles and turn right onto East Gum Ave. The fairgrounds will be on your right.

From I-5 North/SR-99 North: If you come up 99, you will merge onto I-5 north just past Sacramento (goes past the Sacramento International Airport). Follow I-5 north to Ex 537, CA 113S / Woodland. Turn left off the exit ramp onto East Main Street. Follow East Main for approximately 1.1 miles, then turn left on East Street. In .6 miles, turn left onto East Gum Ave. Fairgrounds Entrance will be on your right.

SET UP CREW:

- If you wish to help with set up, please contact Julie Owens (archer12763@gmail.com) by Wednesday, May 20th to be added to the set-up crew list. ONLY SET UP CREW will be allowed to set up ringside or bring their RVs in before 2:00 pm.
- Trial Set up is scheduled to begin around 3:00 pm on Thursday, May 21st.

GATES, GATES, GATES!!!

ARRIVING AT THE TRIAL SITE / RETURNING AFTER DINNER:

- Each day, the Main Fairgrounds entrance gate (off Gum Ave near the RV Park) and the black inner gate open at approximately 6:00 am. If you arrive before 6:00 am, you will have to wait in the entrance drive until the gate is opened. There is a possibility that we may be late in opening the gate.

- Both gates (the black inner gate and the silver RV park gate) will be locked **at 9:00 pm on Thursday, Friday and Sunday**. If you are staying on the grounds and choose to go out after the trial is over, you **MUST** return before 9 pm or you may not be able to get back in.
- While TRACS does have the ability to unlock the gates for emergencies, your staying out too late while socializing does not constitute an emergency. Please be considerate of our people who have been working all day to support the trial. If you come back to the site late, you are asking them get out of bed and make their way across the Fairgrounds to the gates if you don't arrive / get back on time. And that's just bad agility karma!
- FOR AFTER HOURS ENTRY / EXIT HELP:
 - If you have an emergency and need to leave the Fairgrounds after 9:00 pm, you will have to use the emergency exit gate off of East Street.
 - To get this gate unlocked, contact Suzanne Brehm, (916) 847-9155. She is staying on the Fairgrounds.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- **On Saturday, May 24, there is a function in the building just outside the black gates. We must close and lock those gates at 3 pm, so there will be a different route to exit the fairgrounds after that time. This will be briefed on Saturday morning and there will be directions available to show you how to leave the grounds. Again, this affects Saturday only.**
- On Saturday, if you leave the grounds and want to get back in after 3 pm, you will need to use the gate off East Ave. This gate will be open from 3 pm thru 9 pm that day.
- If you are staying on site and, for reasons beyond your control such as traffic accidents or other travel delays, you will arrive after the 9 pm gate closure, you can contact Suzanne Brehm (916) 847-9155 for after hours entry, but please do that as soon as you know you will arrive late.

UNLOADING AND PARKING

- Once through the inner black gate, "Main Street" (the two-lane road that leads from the black gate down through the trial area), will be blocked off in both directions beginning at 7:30 am each day through the end of judging. This is for the safety of exhibitors and dogs.
- If you arrive after 7:30 am, there is an unloading area where you can park temporarily to unload your stuff or you may drive around the perimeter to a Daily Parking area. There is a 15-minute unloading time limit. After that, you must move your car to one of the day parking areas.
- There are a number of areas that we have had access in the past for parking and set up that are no longer available for us to use. Please be sure to look at the attached grounds map to see this year's available space. Also, please respect any areas we have blocked/marked off as out of bounds.
- There are a number of areas inside the Fairgrounds where you can park for the day. See the attached site map for these areas. Please do not park within about 20 feet of an RV hookup or you will be asked to move if an RV needs to park there. No vehicles of any kind (with the exception of the TRACS trailers and tow vehicles), may park on any paved roads/pathways (fire lanes).
- **NOTE: IF YOU ARE GOING TO CRATE OUT OF YOUR VEHICLE AND YOU HAVE THE TYPE THAT HAS "DOG MODE" WHERE THE VEHICLE WILL BE COMPLETELY CLOSED, PLEASE PUT A SIGN ON YOUR DASH WITH YOUR NAME/PHONE NUMBER SO WE CAN CONTACT YOU IN CASE SOMEONE REPORTS A DOG IN DISTRESS.**
- The interiors of all barns/buildings are off limits to cars/set ups. This is a Fairgrounds rule.

EXITING THE FAIRGROUNDS:

- During the day: If you need to depart the Fairgrounds while the trial is underway, you will need to drive the long way around the site back to the main gate.

RINGSIDE CANOPY SETUP:

- The rings will be outside on grass with limited shade, so remember to bring your own shade.
- General exhibitor set up begins at 4:00 pm or when all set up work is finished (trailers unloaded, rings set, fencing up, infrastructure areas set up, canopies up and staked. If you try to set up prior to that time, you will be asked to either stop and wait for the appropriate time, or you can always join in the set-up fun.
- Please ensure all set ups are at least 15' back off the ring ropes.
- There may be no personal canopies set up along the entry/exit side of the rings.
- Note: There are several reserved areas and walk-through spaces that were marked off during set-up. If you set your canopy up in a "designated walk-through area" or other reserved space, you will be asked to move, regardless of the time.

UNATTENDED DOGS:

In accordance with AKC rules, all dogs must be on leash and attached to a human being. Please do not tie your dog to any of the club canopies, leave them unattended in/on chairs, or in an unattended down stay next to the ring while walking your course. If you are early in the running order, you can bring a crate to ringside to stage your dog so you can be ready immediately following the walk through. However, you will have to remove it after your run to keep congestion down near the rings. Also, remember that there will be a five-minute break from the end of each walk through to the first dog on the line.

RV PARKING:

- Overnight parking (RVs, Trailers, cars/van, tents) is by **advance registration only**.
- Only trial key workers will have **assigned** parking spots.
- Suzanne Brehm, the RV Coordinator, will be sending out a general map to all those who have sent in an RV parking request. This map will have RV parking locations identified.
- General RV Parking is on a first come, first serve basis.
- RVers not on the set up list may come into park at 3:00 pm. If you get to the Fairgrounds before 3:00 pm, please wait in the outer parking lot.
- RVers may not set up ring side before the 4:00 pm general set up time

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG: Please clean up after your dog. Nuff said...

DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN YOUR VEHICLE WITH INSUFFICIENT VENTILATION!

- If a dog appears in heat distress, we will try to find out who the vehicle belongs to. However, if we judge the dog is in distress, we will take steps to remove the dog from the vehicle. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals!
- **NOTE: IF YOU ARE GOING TO CRATE OUT OF YOUR VEHICLE AND YOU HAVE THE TYPE OF VEHICLE THAT HAS "DOG MODE" WHERE THE VEHICLE WILL BE COMPLETELY CLOSED, PLEASE PUT A SIGN ON YOUR DASH WITH YOUR NAME/PHONE NUMBER SO WE CAN CONTACT YOU IN CASE SOMEONE REPORTS A DOG IN DISTRESS.**

HOSPITALITY:

- There will be no morning hospitality.
- Each day, TRACS will provide lunch for all keyworkers and full time workers. In general, lunch will be available from approximately 11:30 am – 2:00 pm.
- Lunch will be laid out at the Gazebo to the right of the bathrooms near Scoring and Awards, down near Ring 1.

WORKERS We may have some full time workers, but we can still use lots of other help! Worker Sign up Boards will be posted at ring side. Simply sign up on the white board and listen for the Ring Crew Chief to call for your class.

You will earn \$2.00 Worker Bucks per class or division, tickets to our great workers drawing, and, if you work two or more classes, access to the tasty lunch buffet.

Once you have signed up, please check in with your ring crew chief 10 minutes before you are scheduled to work. This really helps keep things moving along. Be sure to come to Scoring at the end of your trial to redeem your worker bucks!

REDEEMING YOUR WORKER BUCKS: At the end of your weekend, bring all your worker bucks to the **Scoring Table** and we will give you a single TRACS voucher in exchange. After the end of this trial, **the individual worker bucks have no value**. You MUST turn them in and get a certificate. Anyone at the scoring table can do this exchange for you.

SCORING, QUESTIONS, POSTING: Scores will be posted on the Arena Wall near Scoring. Please check your results as soon as possible so we may resolve any questions you may have before the judge forgets what your run was like! If you have a question, ask! While it's true the score table is busy, we are never too busy to help you.

Daily results will be taken down each night. You can find daily results on the TRACS Website each night.

If you have any questions about anything other than scoring or have any feedback about ways we can improve our trial, don't be shy about saying something (although I've never really known agility people to be shy about expressing their opinions).

AWARDS:

- We will have your awards ready as soon as we can, but please be patient. AKC requires judges to review all scribe sheets / catalogs prior to awards being available to competitors.
- Awards are self-serve. Stickers can be found in the white stacked drawers in the awards area.
- In addition, class placement and qualifying flats, there are QQ pins for double q's and ribbons for any MACH/PACH/AGCH.
- **IF YOU MIGHT EARN A MACH/PACH or AGCH AT THIS TRIAL, PLEASE LET OUR TRIAL SECRETARY KNOW AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!!**

AGILITY GATE APP: Exhibitors are requested to download the new, free phone app, Agility Gate. The app is free through the iPhone App Store or the Google Play Store. The app has a purple background. **The trial code for this event is 0522 (first day of the event).**

Run orders will be posted each evening. Course maps will be available sometime after 6:00 am each morning. If the maps are not posted exactly at 6:00 am, check back later. Please DO NOT call the trial chair or trial secretary. This is out of our control at this point.

The app gives you access to the course maps, and this is how you will check in for your classes. The app also has a messaging function that the club may use to send out information. Be sure to activate that option in Agility gate if you wish to receive these messages.

You will not need your phone at the gate. There will be iPads (other than the gate stewards') near rings 1 and 2 where you can check the running order. Ring 3 (ISC Ring) will only have the Gate Steward iPad, but you can peer over the Gate Steward's shoulder to find out what you are looking for.

The gate steward will still call your dog's name just like shows in the past. If you have multiple dogs running too close together in the run, then mark them with a "conflict" via the Gate app. If you do not have access to the Agility Gate app, you can ask a friend to mark the conflict for you or you can request THE Gate Steward do this at ringside.

MEASURING: We will have two Volunteer Measuring Officials at this event. The only dogs that **require** measuring are those without height cards or dogs over two years of age who only have one measurement. **THIS INCLUDES DOGS JUMPING IN THE 24" OR 24C class.** Unentered dogs may be measured later in the day.

If you marked that your dog needs to be measured, your dog **MUST** be measured ****BEFORE**** running. Beverly Morgan Lewis and Kathie Leggett are our measuring officials for this event. Morning measuring will be done near the Scoring Area around 7:30 am. Subsequent measuring will be done as required.

CONFLICTS:

For all regular AKC classes and the ISC classes, conflicts will be handled as needed. If you even THINK you might have a conflict, mark your dog as a "conflict" by using the Agility Gate App, or talk to the Gate Steward and they can assist you. We will do everything we can to make sure you get your run, including resetting jump heights once after all dogs have run, so long as you have told us you have a problem. However, we will not hold a ring open once all dogs present at ringside have run; there are other classes to get going.

Remember: with the exception of the Regional WTT classes on Friday (where the dogs must run in order), rings running the smaller classes take precedence over larger classes.

Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as possible within their class.

2026 TRACS Parade of Veterans – This event will take place at/about 8:00 am on Saturday, May 23. Walk thrus in all rings will end at 7::55 am for the Parade so we can all come and celebrate our veteran dogs.

When: We anticipate the match will begin somewhere around 4 pm. We will continue the match as long as we have dogs ringside ready to run, or dusk, whichever comes first.

Why: Proceeds raised will be donated to AKC earmarked for the Senior Agility Open team to help the team defray the cost of its offsite practice in Germany.

Who: Everyone! Dogs do NOT have to be entered in the trial to come play at the fun match

Cost: \$10/run, three run per dog maximum

Toys and training aids permitting in the ring. Please, no food!

ISC CLASS INFORMATION



WHY DID YOU CHOOSE THE NAME “RED POPPY CUP”?

Since World War I, the red poppy has been nationally recognized symbol of sacrifice to honor those who served and died for our country in all wars. It reminds Americans of the sacrifices made by our veterans while protecting our freedoms.

The red poppy came to symbolize the blood shed during battle following the publication of the wartime poem “In Flanders Fields” written by Lt Colonel John McCrae, MD while serving on the front lines during World War I. In 2023, as TRACS looked for a name for our Memorial Day trials ISC Cup, we felt this was the appropriate symbol for an event on this holiday weekend.

COURSE MAPS

- Red Poppy Cup course maps will be available on Agility Gate as usual
- **NorCal World Team Qualifier maps will NOT be posted to Agility Gate.** Hard copy maps will be available for ISC exhibitors to pick up either at ringside or at the Scoring / Trial Secretary’s table/scoring table on Friday.
- When with maps be available:
 - Round 1, Agility: when the course is being numbered
 - Round 2, Jumping: when course building begins

EOTT / WTT Score Entry Requirements:

- The NORCAL Regional WTT Bye Event (A3/J3) and all 8 Red Poppy Cup rounds (A1/J1 & A2/J2) are worth points towards qualifying for the EOTT (which includes the Senior Open Agility Championship Team tryout)
- “Clean Run” scores for the ISC Standard A2 or A3 and ISC JWW J2 or J3 may be used to fulfill WTT Score Entry requirements.

NOTES ON ISC EQUIPMENT

- The tire will be set at FCI height for the 12, 16, 20 and 24” jump heights:
 - The tire is measured to the center of the aperture
 - Large (24”): 32” to center (20” measured at the bottom of the tire opening)
 - Intermediate (20”): 28” to center (16” measured at the bottom of the tire opening)
 - Medium/Small (16/12”): 22” to center (9” measured at the bottom of the tire opening)
- Spread jumps will be built out of two wing jumps; spread bars will be 5’ long in back; 4.5’ long in front
- Long Jump will be the FCI style, (instead of the normal AKC style).
- Jump bars will be 48” long (4.0 feet).

TRIAL SCHEDULE INFORMATION FOR ALL CLASSES

CHECK-IN: Exhibitors can check in via the Agility Gate App any time after the running orders are posted.

MAPS: With the exception of the NorCal Regional World Team Tryouts Qualifier classes, there will no hard copy maps available at the trial. You can print your own map through the Agility Gate App. We will try to have the maps posted on the TRACS website as early as possible.

GENERAL EXHIBITOR BRIEFING: 7:30 am each day. **Why come and listen???** Well, this is where you will get information about the trial specific to each day (stuff that may have come up since this judging schedule was published, changes to the schedule, explanation of the day's events/walkthroughs, and anything else our illustrious Trial Chairs or Trial Secretary needs to talk to you about!)

NOTES TO EXHIBITORS ON SCHEDULE, CLASS ORDER AND, JUMP HEIGHT ORDER

We have put a LOT of work into developing a schedule with an eye towards minimizing conflicts for the greatest number of competitors. Because of this, you will see that the Masters/Excellent classes jump height and ISC jump height order switches around. PLEASE review the attached schedule grid carefully!

WALK THROUGH NOTES:

- The first walkthrough each day will begin as soon as the judges approve their courses.
- Any exhibitor entered in both Premier Standard and Master FAST must walk both courses before judging begins. There are no planned additional walk throughs for these classes.
- After judging begins, all subsequent classes and walkthroughs will start when the previous class is completed.
- There are no mass / general walkthroughs after judging begins.
- For Masters/Excellent classes: Be sure to read the attached schedule carefully! To reduce conflicts, planned jump height orders vary from day to day, and on some days, even class to class. Walkthrough groups are shown as a series of "xx – xx - xx"; walkthrough splits are identified with a semicolon "x;"
- STAY FLEXIBLE!!

MORNING JUDGES' BRIEFINGS: Will take place immediately following the general exhibitor briefing. Subsequent judges' briefings will immediately precede each class.

WHEN DOES JUDGING BEGIN?

Friday:

- Ring 1, Premier Standard – 8:00 am
- Ring 2, Mas/Ex FAST – 8:00 am
- Ring 3, ISC – After Premier Standard end (approx. 9:00 am)

Saturday:

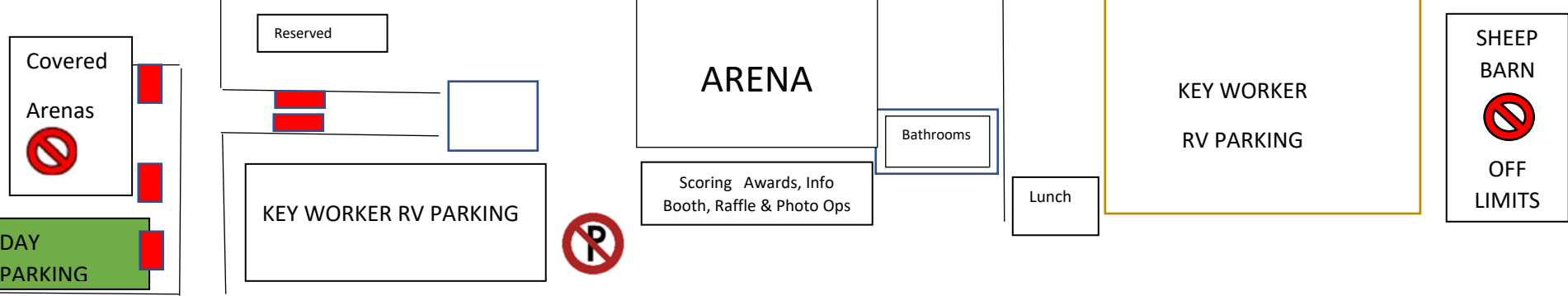
- **IMPORTANT: No additional walk thrus are planned for Premier Standard or Master/Excellent FAST (Rings 1 and 2) after the PoV. So be sure to get to the site early enough to walk before the PoV.**
- Ring 1, Premier Std: after PoV (approximately 8:30 am)
- Ring 2, Master/Excellent FAST: after PoV (approximately 8:30 am)
- Ring 3, Red Poppy Cup, Round 1, after Premier Std (approximately 9:00 am)

Sunday:

- Ring 1, Premier Standard: 8:30 or after Mas FAST large dog have run
- Ring 2, Master/Excellent FAST: 8:00 am
- Ring 3, Red Poppy ISC Cup, Round 6, after Premier Standard (approx. 9:00 am)

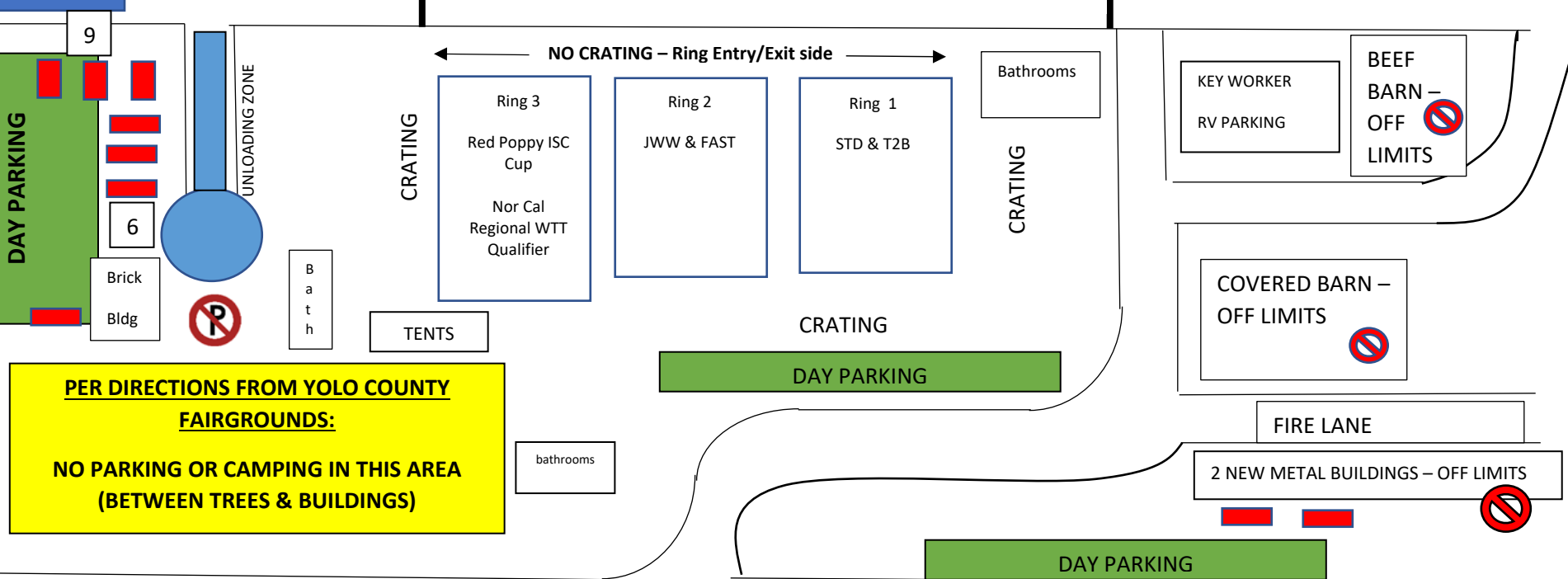

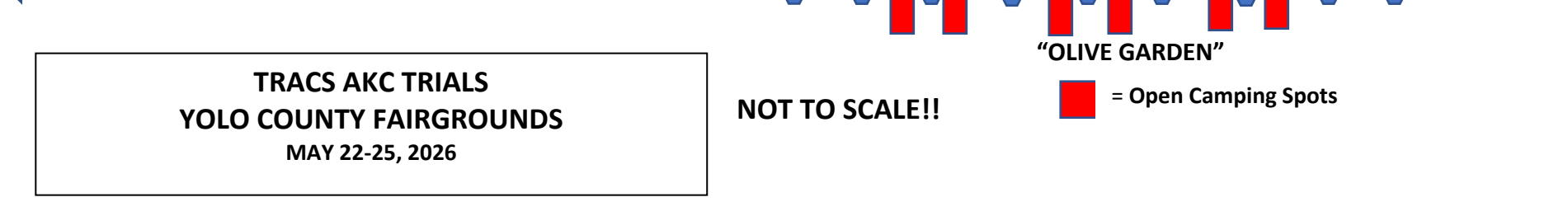
