

RV Arrival and Parking Information

Hi everyone,

I will be the **RV Czar** for the 2026 TRACs Memorial Weekend. When you arrive on the fairgrounds, please check in with me. If you don't see me, please feel free to call my (Suzanne) cell 916.847.9155

Gate Hours:

The main and black gates are as follows:

- Thursday: 8:30am – 9pm
- Friday – Monday: 6am – 9pm

If you arrive prior to the gate being opened, please be prepared to wait in the outer parking lot and be patient until we can get the gates unlocked.

If you need to leave the fairgrounds and then return AFTER 9pm, you will not be able to return to the main gates, as they locked. You will need to use the entrance gate off East Street. For after-hours assistance, please contact me.

Set-up and Arrival:

Thursday – Set-up

If you are not part of the set-up crew, but would like to be, please contact Nita or Julie Owens...**we welcome your help!** If don't plan to help with set-up, you may enter the fairgrounds after 4:00pm – please wait in the outer parking lot until 4pm.

Thursday's schedule is as follows:

9-11:00 am TRACs trailer and Toch & Go trailer (ISC equipment) arrive

2:30 pm Only set-up crew may arrive, park their RVs(if applicable) and drop a crate/tarp/canopy

2:30-3:30 pm Set-up takes place

4:00 pm General Exhibitors may arrive and set up RVs and/or ringside

PLEASE REFER TO THE ATTACHED MAP FOR AVAILABLE RV/TENT SPACES:

If you are a **key worker**, we have specific areas reserved for you...they should be marked by a **red landscape flag**, however they are also marked by a yellow box on the map.

If you are not a key worker, the map will show general areas where electrical hookups are available (red boxes). Spots are on a first come first serve basis.

Electrical:

The fairgrounds mainly have 50-amp hookups. If you need a 30-amp, please bring an adapter with you. Also, you may be asked to share a 50-amp so an adapter that will split the 1 50-am into 2 30-amps would also be handy to have. It would also be prudent to bring an RV extension cord in case you need that little extra reach to the hook-up.

There are quite a few 110 hook-ups available throughout the fairgrounds-some are standalone plugs, but the majority are on the same post as the 5-amps.

Water:

While the fairgrounds have added electrical hook-ups, they have also removed several water faucets. Be sure you **fill your tanks prior to arriving** since we cannot guarantee a water hook-up.

Showers:

The fairgrounds does not have showers on site
