Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Equipment and Obstacles

Equipment is provided by Kathie Leggett and TRACS. Obstacles will meet the specifications for ISC classes in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility. The ring may not be fully fenced and there will be no ring gates used.

Fee Schedule

Entry fee: \$22 for the first entry of a dog; \$22 for each additional entry of the same dog per day.
Junior Handlers (must have AKC Junior Handler number and be handling their own or immediate family member's dog): \$11 for the first entry of a dog; \$11 for each additional entry of the same dog per day. Unfortunately, emailed/Paypal entries will NOT be accepted at this trial due to club decision.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded 1st - 4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Qualification ribbons will not be awarded at this trial unless requested. Additionally, other awards will be given to top finishers in the Red Solo Cup Finals A3 course. Details about those awards and eligibility will be described below.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
- FEO is available in all classes.
- Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare FEO through the Agility Gate app the day of the trial.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day-of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring to the judge and the scribe **prior to leading out.**

Fix and Go On (FNG)

- Fix and Go On (FNG) is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.
- FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation.
- This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.
- FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.
- Exhibitors are not to signal they are using FNG – the judge will signal the scribe appropriately.

Bitches in Season (BIS)

BIS will be permitted to compete at this event. Handlers with bitches in season are requested to indicate this on the run order prior to their run and take appropriate precautions to minimize disruption.

Jump Heights

Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights; however, only those dogs running in the 12," 16," 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoffs (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualifications for WTT or EOTT. Please see the 2026 EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- **Small** (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " or less at the withers
- **Medium** (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and up to 16 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers.
- **Intermediate** (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16 $\frac{7}{8}$ " but less than 18 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers.
- **Large** (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 18 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers

Qualifications

"Clean run" scores from ISC Classes at official FCI jump heights, 12", 16", 20", and 24," may be used to fulfill the qualification requirements for WTT/EOTT. A "clean run" consists of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class.

Course Walk Through / Warm Up Area

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided.

Agility Trial Site Directions

From the Bay Area via I-80 East: Take I-80 East towards Sacramento. Exit I-80 onto CA-113 North (just past Dixon) towards Woodland for 8.7 miles. Take Exit 34, Road 25A. Follow Rd 25A for approximately .45 miles and turn right onto East Street. Follow East Street for 1.88 miles and turn right onto East Gum Ave. The fairgrounds entrance will be on your right.

From I-5 North/SR-99 North: If you come up 99, you will merge onto I-5 North just past Sacramento (goes past the Sacramento International Airport). Follow I-5 North to Exit 537, CA 113S / Woodland. Turn left off the exit ramp onto East Main Street. Follow East Main for approximately 1.1 miles, then turn left on East Street. In .6 miles, turn left onto East Gum Ave. The fairgrounds entrance will be on your right.

Volunteers

Trials cannot happen without the help of volunteers. If you have time to set a bar, run a leash, time, scribe or gate – even if it is only for ten dogs – it will help immensely. We will break up running into two halves per class so that workers in either half will have time to warm up their dog before they are set to run in the next half. We will also need a Ring Chief, Chief Course Builder, and Hospitality Chief—if interested, please contact Channan at c.fosty@comcast.net.

DEADLINE for Overnight Parking Reservations: October 15th, 2025

COST:

For anyone not sleeping in a tent (includes vans/autos as well as RVs/Trailers), with or without power or water: \$35/night

For tents: \$15/night (no power/water)

Only key worker RVs will have pre-assigned spaces. All other RV parking inside the fairgrounds will be first come, first served. You must still send in an Overnight Parking/Camping Form (found [HERE](#) on the website) accompanied by payment. The Club (Sandra) will issue Overnight Parking/Camping Permits that must be displayed while parked during the trial.

If you arrive before the Club has had an opportunity to mark reserved RV spots, and you end up parked in a spot that has been reserved for a key worker, you will be required to move.

An RV site map will be included with the judging schedule so you will have some idea of what power is available in which locations and where water may be available.

There is an actual RV park in the area between Gum Ave and the chainlink gate (to your right as you drive in). To reserve a space there, you will NOT send in your RV reservation to the Trial Secretary. This park is run/managed by the Fairgrounds. This park has 30/50 amp power, water,

and sewer. The cost here is \$45/night. You can make your reservation for the Yolo County Fairgrounds RV park here: <https://www.yolocountyfair.net/>

Dry Campers/Day Parkers: Do not park in a powered spot! You will be required to move.

Red Solo Cup - International Sweepstakes Classes (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard (Agility) and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the “Challenge of the Day” when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to all dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC. Dogs may enter at their preferred jump height; however, they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping their regular height. For example: 16” preferred dogs will be scored against 20” regular division dogs. Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC. At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the information in this premium list may run any level.

Red Solo Cup Winners in the A3 Final

The ISC Agility 3 (ISC A3) Final class on Sunday **can be entered by anyone**; however only certain teams can win the Red Solo Cup based on their score in Sunday’s A3 ISC Agility class. In order to be eligible to win the Red Solo Cup, teams:

- Must be entered in at least one of the ISC classes other than the Sunday ISC A3 class
- Must be entered in the Sunday ISC A3 class
- Must (a) finish one of the previous ISC runs in the top 40% of their jump height as scored on a Faults then Time basis, (b) finish under the Standard Course Time (SCT) defined by the judge of record, and (c) not have a result of an “E,” defined as going off course or accumulating 3 or more refusals in a run.

There will be a podium for the top 3 finishers in each height in the Sunday ISC A3 class out of the competitors satisfying the above criteria.

Placements for the Red Solo Cup Finals will be based on individual scores in the final class, as scored on a Faults then Time basis. Eligible scores will be under SCT and not have a result of an “E” as described above.

First place finishers in each height will receive a special prize which is TBD. Please follow the Facebook page for the Red Solo Cup for further details.

NOTE: Since the Sunday ISC A3 class can be entered by ANYONE, a “clean run” in the class can be used for WTT/EOTT qualifications as defined by the rules for WTT/EOTT.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing / Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners dogs provided their listing number has been recorded on entry form. Exceptions: aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fee.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, an act of God, an act of Mother Nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the Ring or when in the designated agility/warm up areas.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Trial rings may not be fully fenced and there will not be ring gates used at this trial.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program**SM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as "All American Dog" and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club by calling (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, please specify the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner.
