IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS:

- If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation information and judging schedule. Please make sure the Trial Secretary's email address: (VCDK9s@comcast.net) is allowed by your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address.
NOTE: ENTRIES RECEIVED WITH POSTAGE DUE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BUT WILL BE RETURNED TO SENDER WITHOUT ACTION
- Move ups will be accepted until **6 pm Monday, July 13, 2015**
- **ENTRY FEES (PER DOG,):** \$20.00 - 1ST Class; \$15.00 – 2nd class /\$15.00 - 3rd class (includes AKC Recording Fees of \$3 for each run).
- **No vouchers will be accepted at this trial.**
- Each exhibitor will get **2 people credentials (tickets) and 1 parking credential. Do not forget these as there are no replacements!!**
- There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial.
- **SHOW SITE: This show will be held indoors on hard packed dirt. Ring dimensions will be 100' by 100'**
- **Wait List:** SDTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials' closing date/time. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 pm on July 1, 2015. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on July 13, 2015 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a refund will be "issued" by destroying the entry check. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on July 12, 2015 will have their check destroyed OR it can be returned if a SASE is included with the entry.

AWARDS

- Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height. Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH or PACH. If you anticipate you may complete your MACH or PAX at our trial, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary by the preceding Monday.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.
- Running order will be determined by a random draw, and handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- No hand delivery of entries within the first 24 hours after the opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- **There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or bitches in season. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified prior to the trial.** In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
- Ring will be enclosed by cattle gates
- Electronic timing will be used.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- **It is ESSENTIAL that you clean up after your dog.** Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- On Call Veterinarian: UCD vets on site
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
- **Course Familiarization/Warm-ups** Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: REGULAR TITLING CLASS

Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an AKC agility title.

Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: PREFERRED TITLING CLASSES

Open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in AKC Agility Trial regulations. Dogs may be entered in either Preferred class or the Regular class at any trial. The dog must be entered ONLY in Preferred or Regular classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. So, if you want to enter your dog in Preferred classes on **Saturday**, you must also enter Preferred on **Sunday**.

Novice – All dogs entering the Preferred Classes **for** the first time must enter the Novice level regardless of the previous titles. Novice Preferred is NOT split into A and B divisions.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice Preferred or Open Preferred titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent Preferred class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open Preferred title, but have not completed the Excellent Preferred title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have completed the Excellent Preferred title.
