Closing Date: Entries will be accepted until 5:00 PM on Thursday, January 18, 2018, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

Entry Fee: \$100.00. A \$0.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to **TRACS**.

Tracking Test Entries: Dogs holding the title of Tracking Dog Excellent shall not be barred from competition; however, dogs not having a TDX will be given preference by the Test Secretary. Entries are limited to 3 dogs. No mixed breed dogs will be accepted for this test.

The Draw: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, January 18, 2018 at 5:30 PM, Jack in the Box, 8655 Auburn Blvd., Roseville, CA

Alternate List: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries which are to run.

Notification: Notification of the draw results will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary. Judging Program will be provided by email and USPS Mail.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Test Worker Option: One (1) TDX track will be reserved for test workers who have earned required credit. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test worker is chosen. The remaining workers will automatically be included in the drawing with all other tracking entries received.

Refund policy: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track. All alternates not given the opportunity to run a track will receive a refund of their entry fees.

Bitches in season may participate: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

Draw for running order: All entrants must be at the test site by 9:45 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

Judging will begin as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

Awards: A dark green qualifying ribbon, a rosette, and a photograph will be awarded to each passing team.

Dogs on leash: All dogs and bitches entered in this test must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site. This also applies to any non-entered dogs that may accompany anyone at this test.

Directions to test site: From Sacramento take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Zinfandel Dr. exit and go South approx 4 miles to Douglas Rd. Proceed straight across Douglas Rd. After crossing Douglas, continue 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. **From Placerville** take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento. Exit on Sunrise Blvd. South. Proceed south 4 miles to Douglas Rd. Turn Right onto Douglas and proceed to traffic signal at Zinfandel Dr. (formerly Eagles Nest Rd.) Turn Left onto Zinfandel, go 2/10 of a mile and turn Left into Mather Field Rotary Park.

Practicing is allowed in the fields. Please respect the signs that indicate where dogs are allowed.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
