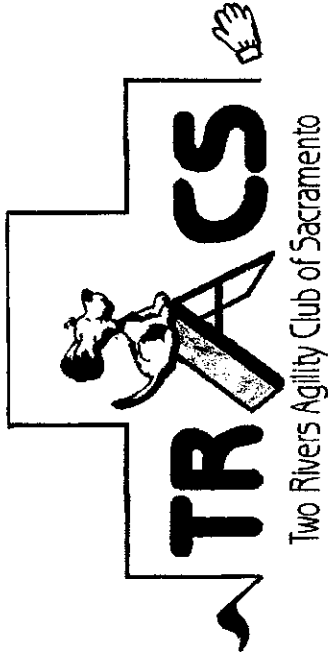

Closing Date: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Wednesday, February 5, 2003 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

Entry Fee: \$35.00. A \$.50 recording fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to TRACS.

Tracking Test Entries: Dogs holding the title of Tracking Dog shall not be barred from competition; however, dogs not having a TD will be given preference by the Test Secretary. Entries are limited to 12 dogs.

The Draw: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, February 6th at 6:00 PM at Round Table Pizza, 5101 Folsom Blvd., Sacramento, CA 95819.

Alternate List: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries which are to run.

Certification: An original written statement must accompany each entry for a licensed or member tracking test for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD test. This statement must be dated within one year of the date the test is to be held, signed by a person approved by the AKC to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

Notification of the draw results will be made on as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

Refund policy: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

Bitches in season may participate: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

Draw for running order: All entrants must be at the test site by 7:00 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

Judging will begin as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

Awards: An award will be offered for each dog passing the test.

Dogs on leash: "All dogs and bitches entered in this test must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards. This also applies to any non-entered dogs that may accompany anyone at this test."

Directions to test site: From Sacramento take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Sunrise Blvd. South exit and go 4 miles to Douglas Rd. Turn right on Douglas Rd. and go 1 mile to Eagles Nest Rd. Turn left on Eagles Nest Rd. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. From Placerville take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions.

Practicing is allowed in the fields. The areas we are allowed to use are anything on the right after you turn onto Eagles Nest (except the fenced area where the horses are) all the way to Woodring Rd. and anything on the left past the golf course. Please do not use the area on the right beyond Woodring as dogs are no longer allowed in that area.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" and if this entry is for an obedience trial, the "Obedience Regulations" have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims and causes of action that I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC-approved judge judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations, and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless for any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and for any claim for damage, or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., Over 13 in. But not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wire-haired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. (Actual Owners) A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

JUNIOR HANDLERS

By signing the entry form we certify that the Junior Handler does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in the Junior Showmanship program.

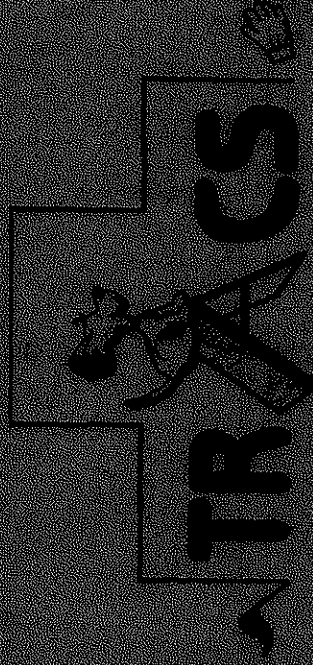
