CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Thursday, December 3, 2026, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. All entries must be delivered to Karey Krauter, 374 Stanford Ave, Palo Alto CA 94306. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

TEST LIMIT: **VST** entry is limited to three (3) dogs. **TDU** entry is limited to three (3) dogs.

ENTRY FEE: **VST** entry fee is \$150.00 payable in US dollars. **TDU** entry fee is \$100.00 payable in US dollars. Fees include \$4.50 AKC recording fee). Make checks payable to TRACS.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be at 6:15 PM on Thursday, December 3, 2026, at Starbucks, located at 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto CA 94306.

WORKER PREFERENCE: For EACH of the **VST** and the **TDU** tests, one track will be given to TRACS/SDTC test workers who submit TRACS/SDTC issued vouchers with their entry forms. See the TRACS website at agiltracs.org for details of the test worker preference process.

ALTERNATE LIST: Alternate lists will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate lists will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

NOTIFICATION: Notification of the draw results will be made by email as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

TEST HOURS: 6:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Judging will begin as soon as tracks have aged sufficiently.

DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: All entrants must be at their respective test sites for the draw for their test at which time there will be a draw for the running order for that test. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

TDU Draw: 8:00AM Dec 13, at Elk Grove Park, the Dog Park parking lot.
VST Draw: 10:30AM Dec 13, at Cosumnes College, parking lot F.

AWARDS: A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each passing dog.

DOGS ON LEASH: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

ELIGIBILITY: For the **VST**: all AKC registered dogs that have earned a **TD**, **TDU**, or **TDX** title are eligible to enter this test. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the **VST** title. Dogs who have not earned the **VST** title will be given priority for entry in the **VST**. For the **TDU**: all AKC registered dogs at least six (6) months of age that are eligible for entry and that meet AKC eligibility requirements are eligible to enter this test. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the titles **TD**, **TDU**, **TDX** or **VST**. Dogs not holding any tracking title will be given priority for entry in the **TDU**. Dogs not holding any tracking title must include a judge's certification with their entry.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate. Notify Test Secretary as soon as you arrive if your bitch is in season.

DOGS IN VEHICLES: Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the sponsoring club for disciplinary action. All persons attending this test hereby waive any claim for damages against TRACS or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person; theft of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal; or any loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site or in transit to/from the site.

FOOD: Be aware that there will be **NO FOOD** (lunch, snacks) at this event. We will have bottled water available. Please bring your own snacks and lunch as you see fit!



TDU - DIRECTIONS TO ELK GROVE REGIONAL PARK:

From Highway 99S coming from Sacramento- Exit Elk Grove Blvd. Turn left onto Elk Grove Blvd. **From Highway 99N coming from Stockton -** Exit Elk Grove Blvd. Turn left onto E. Stockton Blvd. Turn right onto Elk Grove Blvd.

From Elk Grove Blvd: Turn right onto Elk Grove-Florin Road. Turn right at Gate 1, Main Entrance, to enter Elk Grove Regional Park. Follow park signs to the Dog Park which will be on the right. Test HQ is in the Dog Park parking lot, at the end of the parking lot where the restrooms are, opposite of the fenced dog run area.

Elk Grove Regional Park is city property and proof of current rabies vaccination for each dog on site may be required. In order to protect our right to use the property, respect others using the area and follow all rules in effect, including leash laws.

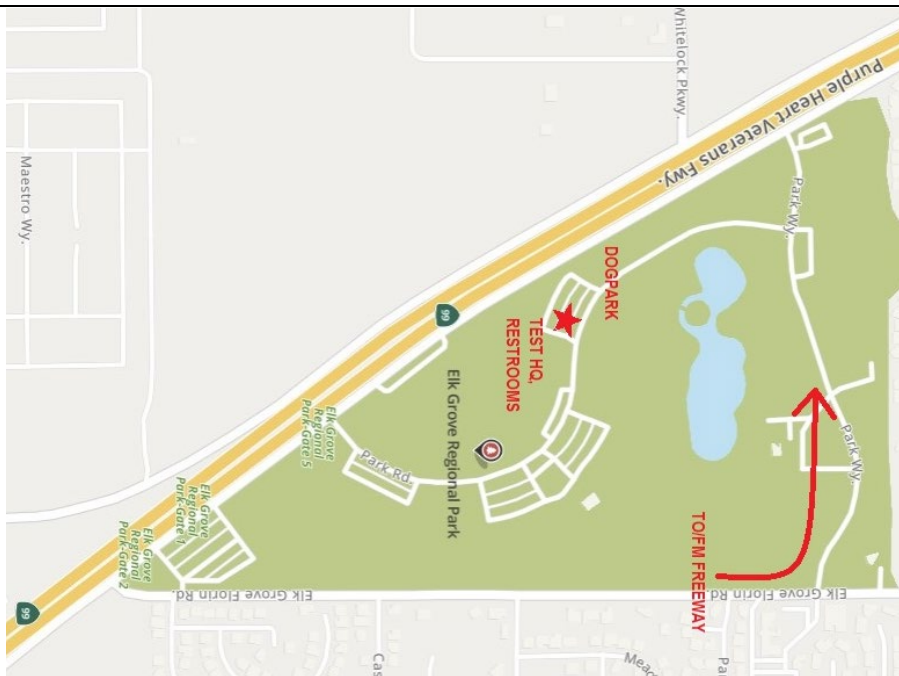
VST - DIRECTIONS TO COSUMNES RIVER COLLEGE:

From Highway 99 - Take Exit 289, Cosumnes River Blvd./Calvine Road. Turn West onto Cosumnes River Blvd. Turn left onto Bruceville Road, then turn right into the CRC East campus entrance. We will be set up in the parking lot F on your right as you enter the campus.

IMPORTANT - 10-DAY RULE

- No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within ten (10) days prior to the date of the event (Chap 1, Section 12, paragraph 8).
- People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 10 days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler. The judges will determine the order in which the tracks are run and the number of each track. (Chap 2, Section 9, paragraph 4).

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
