**Bitches in season may participate:** If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

**Draw for running order:** All entrants must be at the test site by 9:30 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

**Judging will begin** as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

**Awards:** A dark green qualifying ribbon and a rosette will be awarded to each passing dog.

**Dogs on leash:** "All dogs and bitches entered in this test must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards. This also applies to any non-entered dogs that may accompany anyone at this test."

**Directions to CRC test site:**

**Northbound on Hwy. 99:** Exit at Cosumnes River Boulevard/Calvine Road Turn left on to the overpass. Turn left onto Bruceville Road, then turn right into the CRC East Campus entrance. We will be set up in the parking lot on your right, once you enter the campus.

**Southbound on Hwy. 99:** Exit at Cosumnes River Boulevard/Calvine Road. Turn right at the light. Turn left onto Bruceville Road, then turn right into the CRC East Campus entrance. We will be set up in the parking lot on your right, once you enter the campus.

**Closing Date:** Entries will be accepted until 5:00 PM on Thursday, October 20, 2011 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

**Entry Fee:** \$125.00. A \$1.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to TRACS.

**Tracking Test Entries:** Dogs holding the title of Variable Surface Tracking Dog shall not be barred from competition; however, dogs not having a VST will be given preference by the Test Secretary. Entries are limited to 6 dogs.

**The Draw:** A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, October 20, 2011, 6:00pm at Tupelo Coffee House, 5600 Elvas Ave., Sacramento, CA 95819.

**Alternate List:** An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries which are to run.

**Notification:** Notification of the draw results will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary. Judging schedule will be provided by email and USPS Mail.

**Refund policy:** The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track. All alternates not given the opportunity to run a track will receive a refund of their entry fees.

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wire-haired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
