Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

ENTRY FEE: \$60.00 payable in US dollars (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event fee). Make checks payable to TRACS.

CERTIFICATION: Each entry for a dog that has not previously passed an AKC Tracking Dog Test must be accompanied by a written statement dated within one year of the test date, signed by a person approved by AKC to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test. Certifications will be returned to the entrants who do not run their dogs in this test.

ELIGIBILITY: Test is limited to 6 dogs with appropriate Certification or have previously passed a TD or TDU test. Dogs holding the title of Tracking Dog shall not be barred from competition; however, dogs not having a Tracking Dog title will be given preference by the Test Secretary.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be at 6:15 PM on Thursday, February 9, 2023, at Starbucks, located at 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto CA 94306.

TEST WORKER OPTION: One (2) tracks will be reserved for test workers who have earned sufficient required credit at past TRACS/SDTC tests. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test worker is chosen. The remaining test worker entrants will automatically be included in the drawing with all the other tracking entries received. See the TRACS website at <u>agiltracs.org</u> for details of the test worker preference process.

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

TEST HOURS: 6:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Judging will begin as soon as tracks have aged sufficiently.

DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: All entrants must be at the test site by 9:00 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

AWARDS: A rosette ribbon will be awarded to each passing team.

BITCHES IN SEASON: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

DOGS ON LEASH: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the bench show Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim against TRACS and its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person; theft of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal; or any loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site or in transit to/from the site.

VACCINATIONS: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

SITE INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS: From Sacramento, take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Zinfandel Dr. South exit. Continue on Zinfandel Rd until you reach Douglas Rd. Continue straight on Zinfandel Rd through the signal. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. From Placerville, take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions. Tracking test headquarters is under the gazebo at the Mather Field Rotary Park.

SPECTATOR/DRIVING ACCESS. We are no longer officially allowed any vehicle access on any of the interior roads. We will likely need to drive to the west side of the park when staging for some of the tracks, and there is likely to be a significant walk for exhibitors and spectators (if allowed) into and out of the areas. In addition, the area available for exercising dogs during the event has changed - please look for marked area and/or inquire before exercising your dog at the site.

PRACTICING: Limited practicing on the test site is permitted with these restrictions. No training on the grounds is permitted on the day of the test. Please refrain from using the fields at least 3 days before the test. Please respect all "No Dogs" posted signs.

PARKING FEES: Participants and spectators are responsible for payment of all daily parking fees and must observe all parking regulations. Parking regulations are enforced 24 hours, 7 days per week, 365 days per year (including Sundays & holidays). The fee is \$5 per day payable in cash or credit card on site.
